June 2008

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 508,377 in June 2008, decreasing by 5,359 (-1.0%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$151,511,700 in June 2008, decreasing by approximately \$6.8 million (-4.3%) over May 2008.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,004,511 in June 2008, increasing by 18,355 (+0.9%) over May 2008. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$222,658,455 in June 2008, increasing by approximately \$5.6 million (+2.6%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For June 2008, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 657,348, increasing by 2,393 (+0.4%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in June 2008, totaled \$354,730,917, increasing by approximately \$2.2 million (+0.6%) from May 2008.

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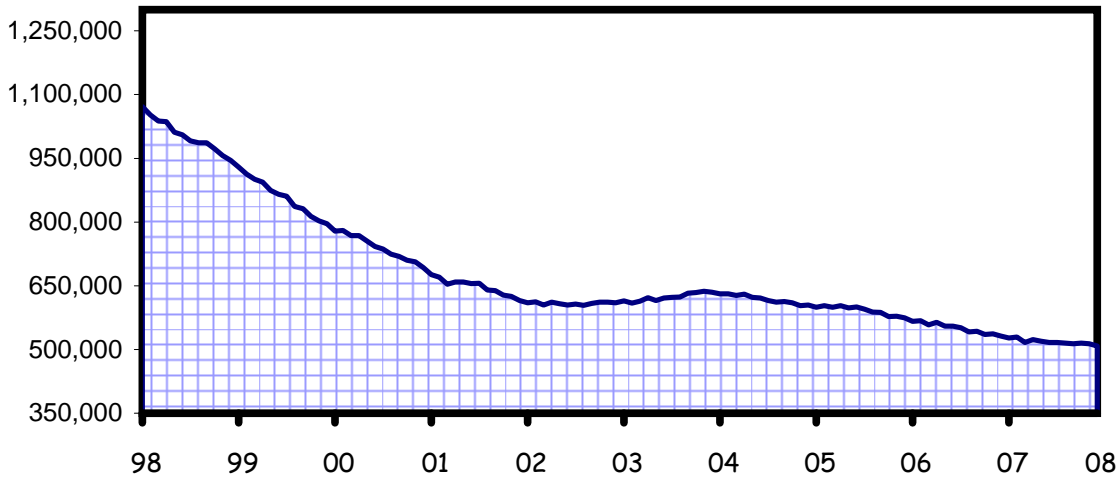
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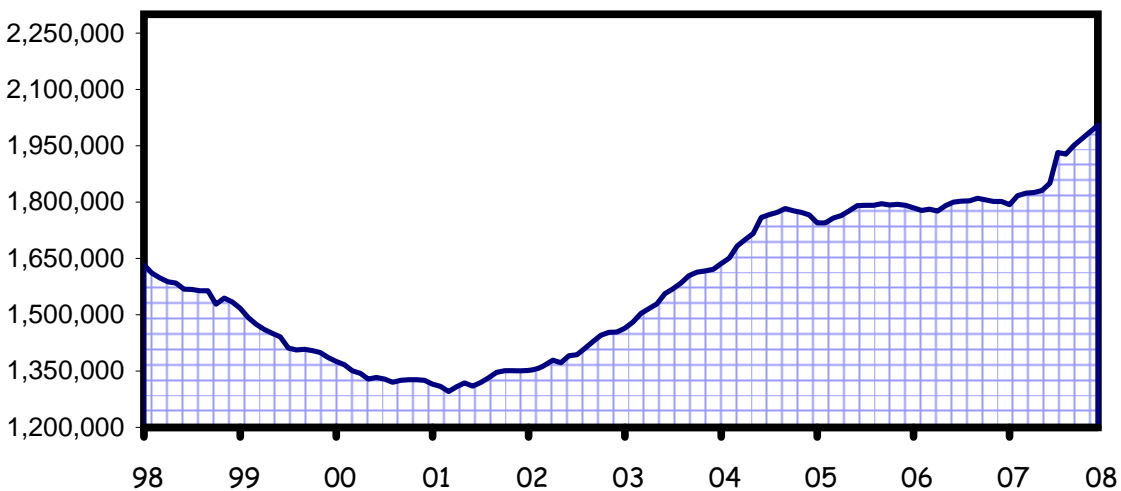
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NEW YORK STATE JULY 1998 - JUNE 2008 TEN YEAR TREND

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

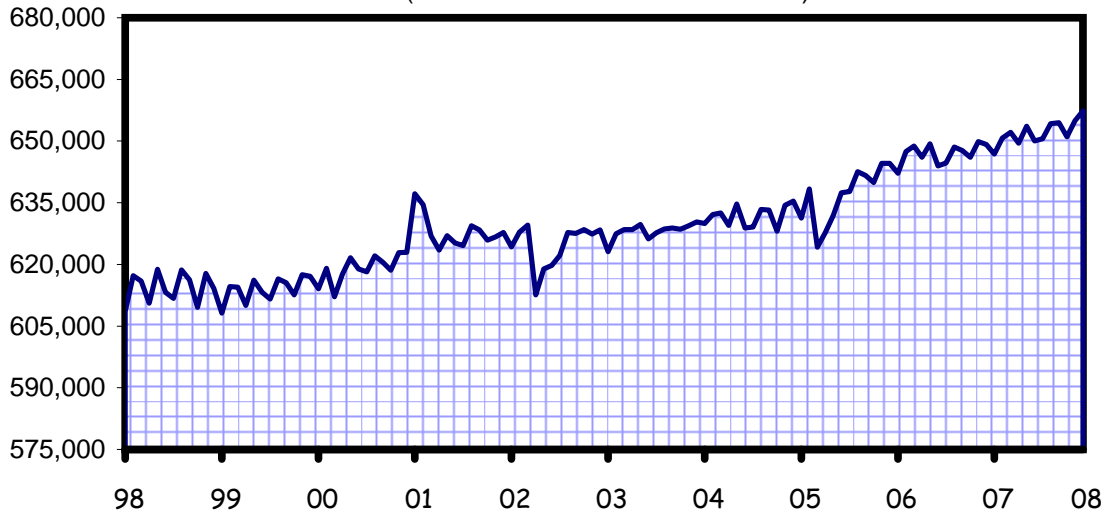


FOOD STAMPS RECIPIENTS
