# **Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics**

## **DECEMBER 2013**

---

### **Temporary Assistance**

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 566,424 in December 2013, decreasing by 2,559 (-0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$183,182,513 in December 2013, increasing by approximately \$3.5 million (+1.9%) over November 2013.

### **Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program**

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,158,376 in December 2013, decreasing by 84,780 (-2.6%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$435,481,255 in December 2013, decreasing by approximately \$94.0 million (-17.8%) from November 2013. The bulk of the decreases from November 2013 were caused by the fact retroactive payments issued to settle litigation inflated recipient and expenditure counts for that month (see note on the cover page of the November 2013 report for details).

### **Supplemental Security Income**

Supplemental Security Income: Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 693,571 in December 2013, decreasing by 10,498 (-1.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$404,362,371 in December 2013, increasing by approximately \$2.9 million (-0.7%) over November 2013.

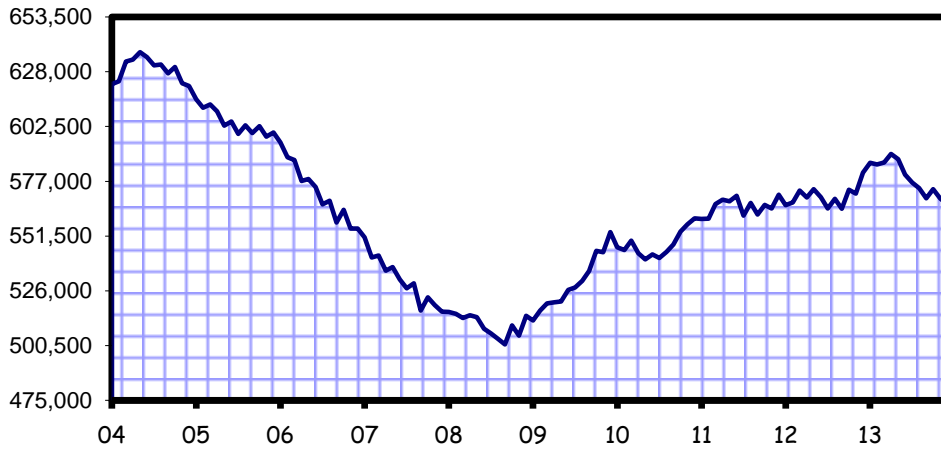

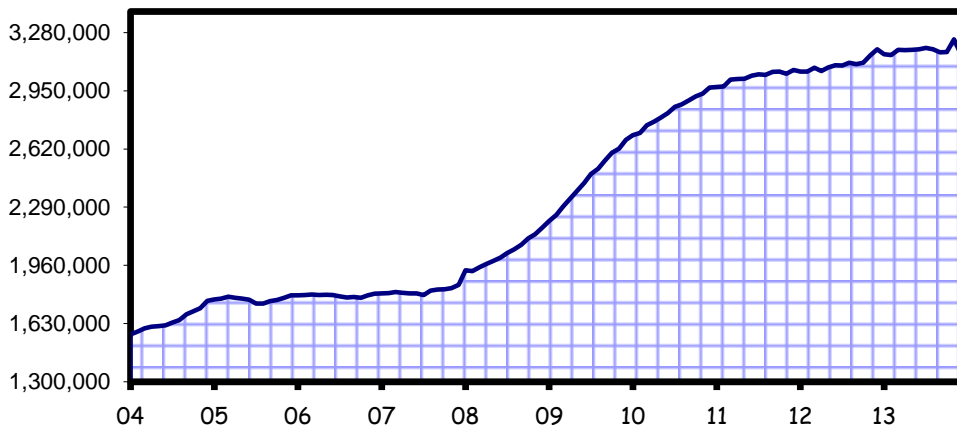

TEN YEAR TREND**

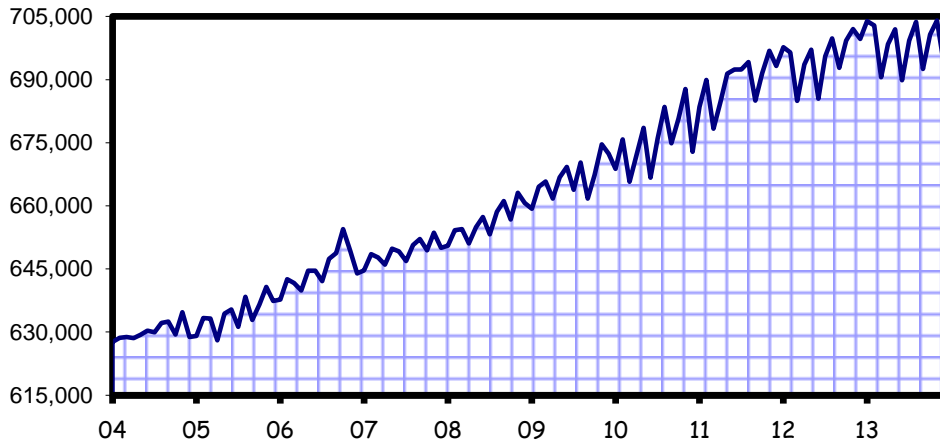
