Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

FEBRUARY 2006

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 588,272 in February 2006, decreasing by 6,915 (-1.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$155,475,406 in February 2006, decreasing by approximately \$2.4 million (-1.5%) over January 2006.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,791,739 in February 2006, increasing by 571 (+0.0%) over January 2006. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$186,532,930 in February 2006, increasing by \$849,460 (+0.5%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For February 2006, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 642,557, increasing 4,809 (+0.8%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in February totaled \$328,781,125, increasing approximately \$6.2 million (+1.9%) from January 2006.

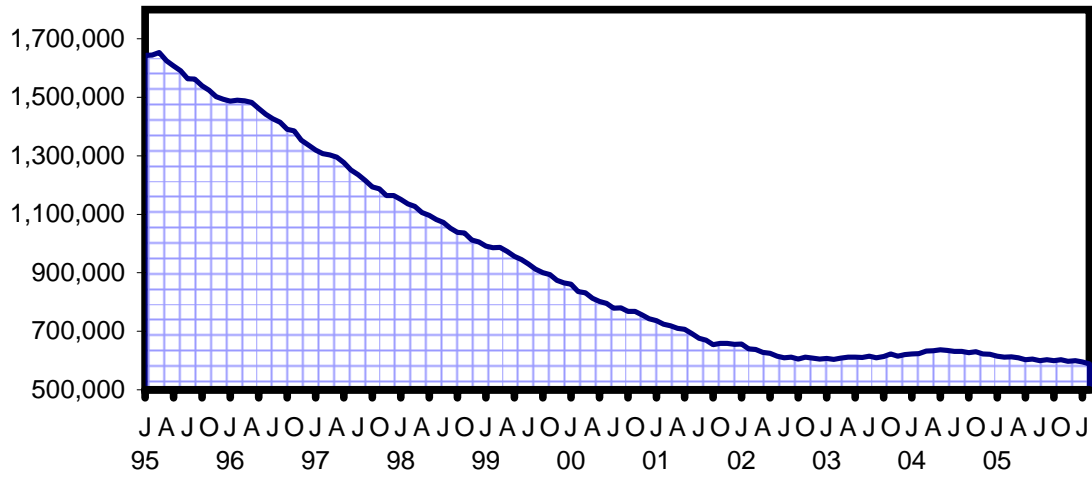

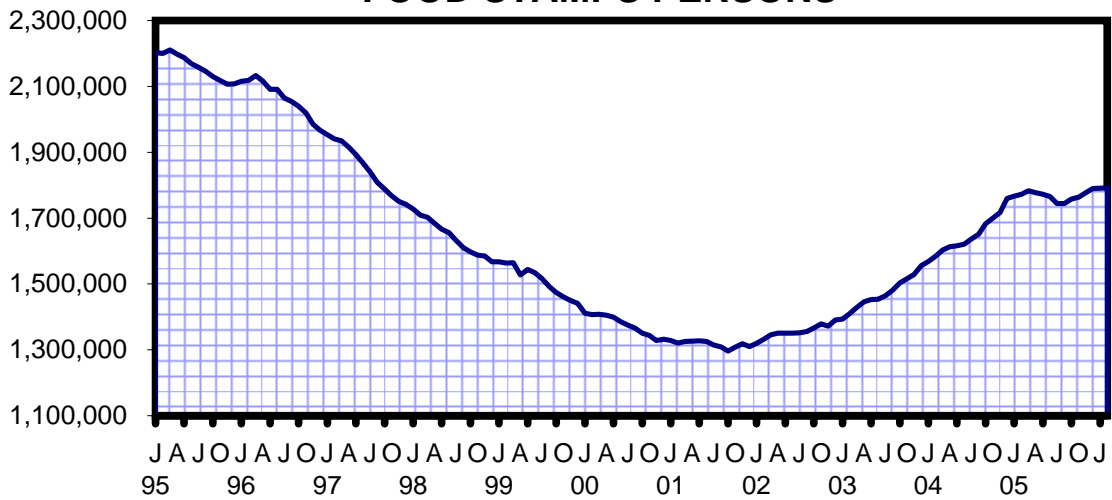

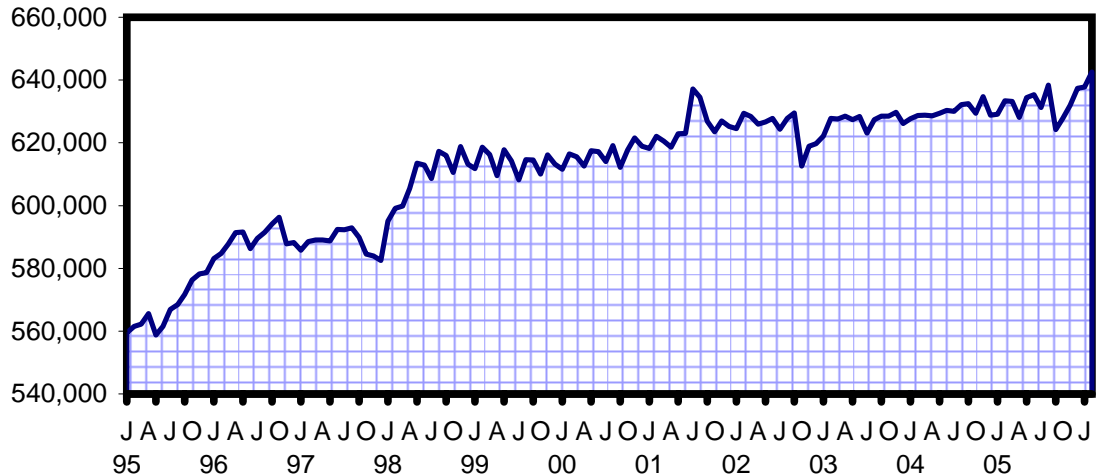
TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS
