Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 531,307 in June 2007, decreasing by 5,773 (-1.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$149,600,896 in June 2007 decreasing by approximately \$3.2 million (-2.1%) over May 2007.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,801,707 in June 2007, decreasing by 146 (-0.0%) over May 2007. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$194,430,741 in June 2007, increasing by \$177,541 (+0.1) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For June 2007, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 649,160 decreasing 700 (-0.1%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in June totaled \$338,866,584 increasing by \$279,291 (+0.1%) from May 2007.

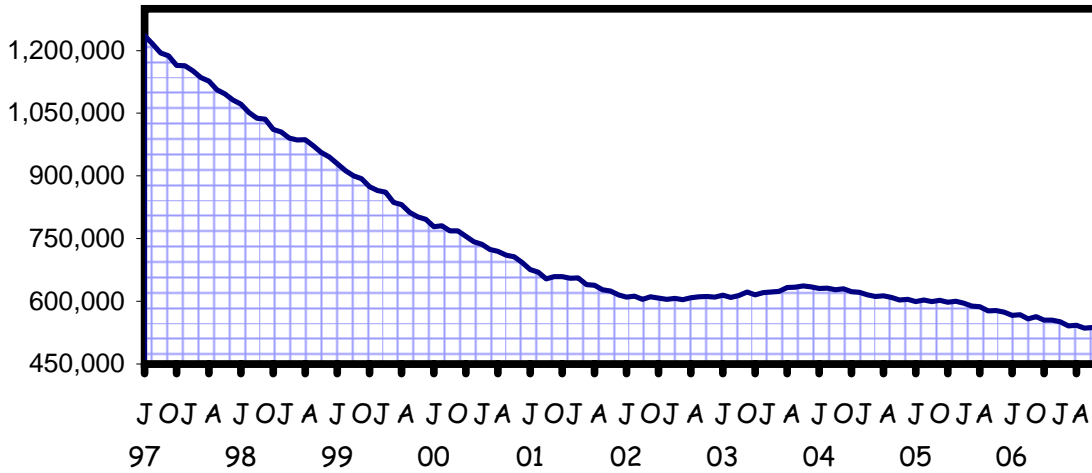
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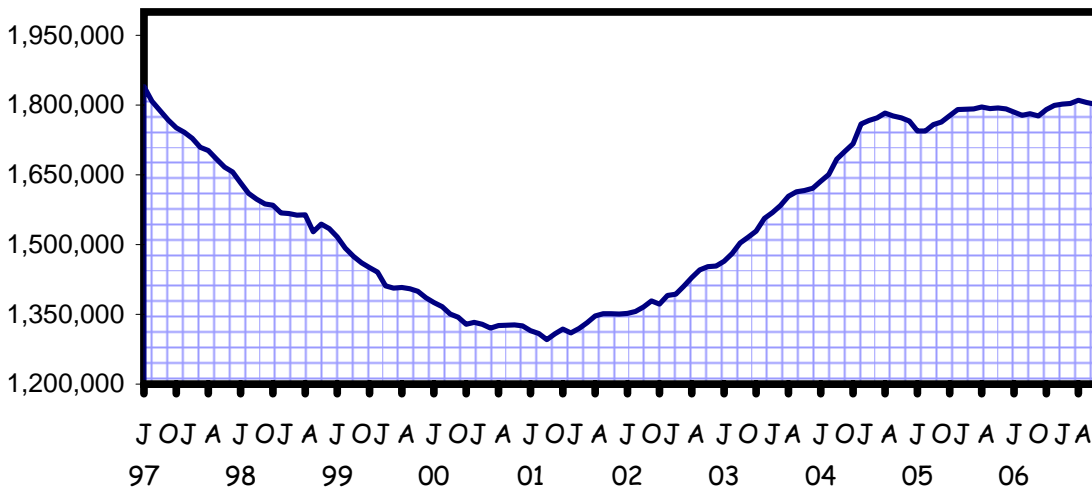
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NEW YORK STATE JULY 1997 - JUNE 2007 TEN YEAR TREND TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

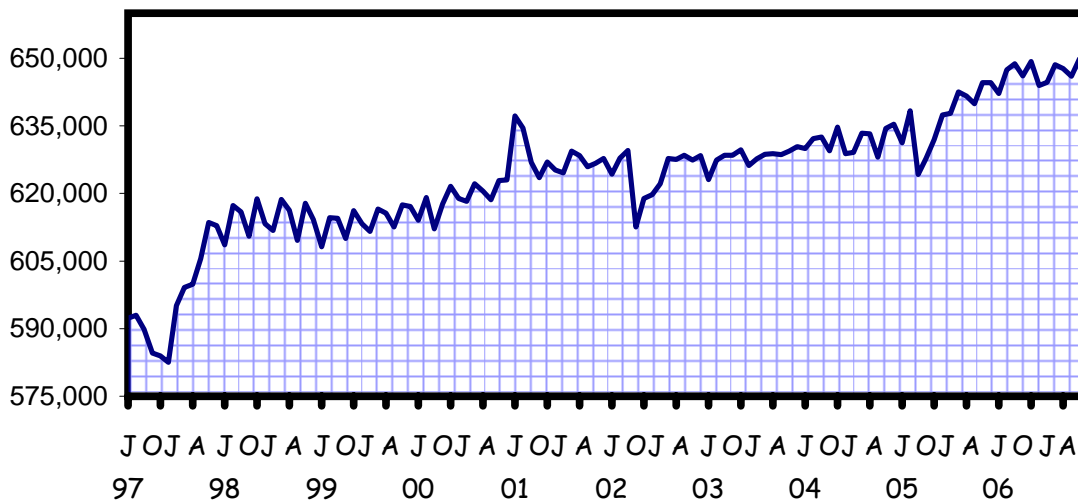


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
