Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

JANUARY 2016

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 566,387 in January 2016, decreasing by 7,650 (-1.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$178,148,426 in January 2016, decreasing by approximately \$12.5 million (-6.5%) over December 2015.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 2,975,036 in January 2016, decreasing by 15,435 (-0.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$411,244,044 in January 2016, decreasing by approximately \$4.6 million (-1.1%) over December 2015.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 704,876 in January 2016, decreasing by 871 (-0.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$413,448,082 in January 2016, decreasing by approximately \$1.5 million (-0.4%) over December 2015.

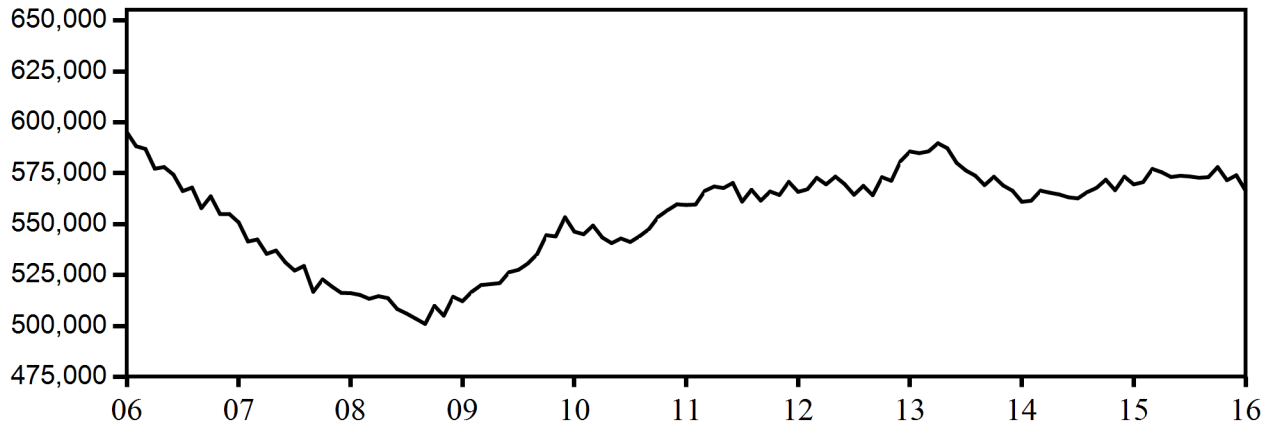

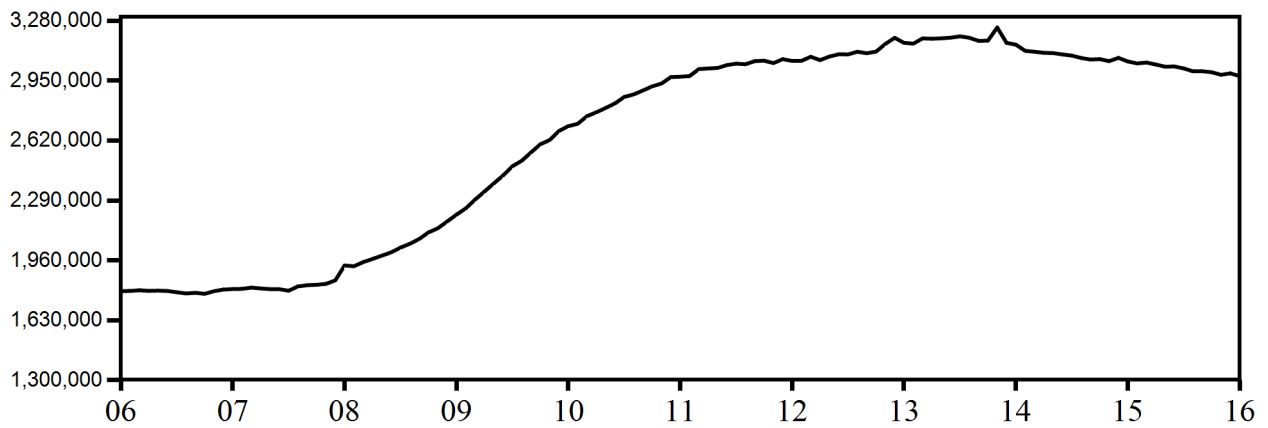

TEN YEAR TREND

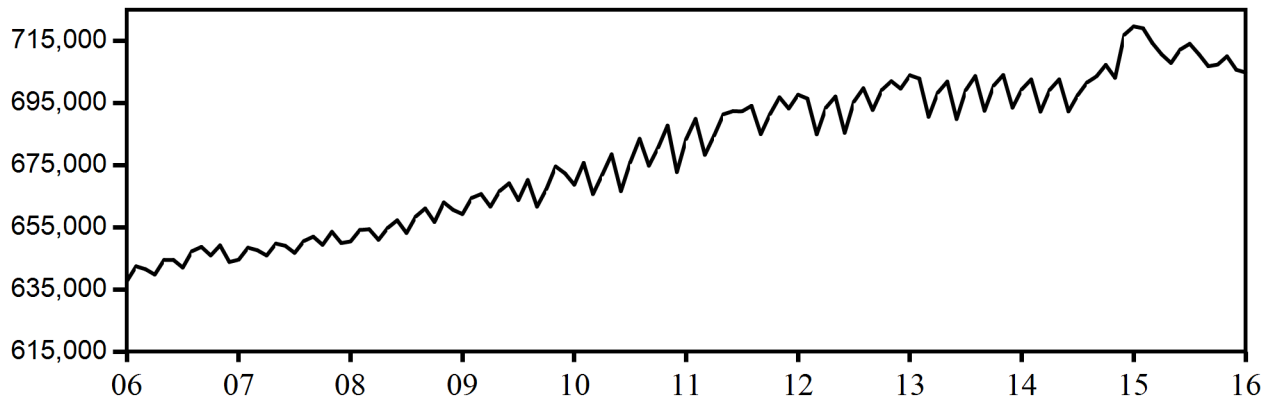
