Consistent with Chapter 862 of the Laws of 1990, the agency named below requested an exemption from initially publishing the contract opportunity in the procurement opportunities newsletter, i.e., the NYS Contract Reporter. In accordance with Section 144(2)(e) of the Economic Development Law, the Office of the State Comptroller has granted the exemption.

The project provides training to LDSS staff and LDSS-contracted educational providers on nutrition programs including the "Eat Smart New York" program. Eat Smart New York provides services to the hard-to-reach Food Stamp populations in New York State. The trainee population includes LDSS Staff involved in the Food Stamp Nutrition Education Programs and "Eat Smart New York" programs, including those operated by Cornell Cooperative Extensions Statewide and Food Change in NYC.
