The purpose of this Informational Letter (INF) is to notify social services districts of the market rate survey New York State Department of Social Services (Department) is conducting.

Market rates as set forth in Section 415.9 of the Department's regulations establish the maximum reimbursable payments for child care services. State law and regulations require that the Department review the local market rates at least once every two years.

The Department is conducting a market rate survey of all registered family day care providers; licensed group family day care providers; licensed day care centers; and registered school-aged child care programs. The attachments to this INF provide social services districts with copies of the information which is being sent to these providers. The instructions and market rate survey have been revised in response to comments from social services districts and other interested parties.
