Section 2

I. Purpose

This release is to notify local districts that the DSS-3570: "Certification Guide" is being obsoleted, as described below.

II. Background

The DSS-3570: "Certification Guide" was originally designed to be used by eligibility workers during the interview and eligibility process. It contained prompts to the workers and areas to note case-specific information and documentation provided by the client. The information in the DSS-3570 has now been incorporated into the upstate 8/01 version of the Common Application LDSS-2921. This 8/01 version was introduced in 01 INF-22 and has now been delivered to all upstate districts. This change is also in the process of being incorporated into the NYC Common Application (LDSS-2921 NYC).

III. Program Implications

Upon receipt and usage of the 8/01 version of the Common Application, the DSS-3570 is obsolete, and local districts should destroy all remaining supplies.
