Safety Net Assistance Project (SNAP) Local District Maximum Funding Levels

Large Districts:

- \$300,000 of the SNAP Funding will be reserved to fund up to 5 proposals in districts listed below whose average caseload is more than double the statewide average.†

Erie, Monroe, Nassau, Onondaga, Suffolk and Westchester

- No proposal request may exceed \$100,000.

Medium Districts:

- \$200,000 of the SNAP Funding will be reserved to fund up to 8 proposals in districts listed below whose average caseload is between one half the statewide average and double the statewide average.†

Albany, Broome, Chautauqua, Chemung, Clinton, Dutchess, Niagara, Oneida, Orange, Oswego, Rockland, St. Lawrence, Schenectady, Sullivan, Tompkins and Ulster

- No proposal request may exceed \$50,000.

Small Districts:

- \$265,000 of the SNAP Funding will be reserved to fund up to 10 proposals in districts whose average caseload is less than half the statewide average.†

Allegany, Cayuga, Cattaraugus, Chenango, Columbia, Cortland, Delaware, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Genesee, Greene, Hamilton, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Montgomery, Ontario, Orleans, Otsego, Putnam, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schoharie, Schuyler, Seneca, Steuben, Tioga, Warren, Washington, Wayne, Wyoming, and Yates

- No proposal request may exceed \$35,000.

†Note: Caseload size is based on average monthly SNA Non-MOE exempt and work-limited individuals during the 12-month period from July 2008 to June 2009. Statewide average does not include districts with a population over two million.
