Section 2

I. Purpose

The purpose of this Informational Letter is to inform social services districts (SSDs) that the January 1, 2015, federal cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for Title II Social Security Retirement, Survivors and Disability Insurance (RSDI) benefits and for Title XVI Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits has been set at 1.7%. The updated SSI and SSP Benefit Levels Chart, with an effective date of January 1, 2015 is attached.

II. Background

The Social Security Administration (SSA) adjusts RSDI and federal SSI benefits to reflect the increase in the cost of living. This cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) increase is based on the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) from the third quarter of the previous year to the third quarter of the current year.

III. Program Implications

This year, there was an increase in the CPI-W from the third quarter of 2013 (the last year a COLA was determined) to the third quarter of 2014. As a result of this CPI-W increase, recipients of RSDI and SSI will have a COLA applied to benefits beginning in January 2015.

The 2015 COLA for RSDI and federal SSI benefits has been set at 1.7%. As authorized by Chapter 58 of the Laws of 2014, the full amount of the 2015 federal COLA will be passed along to all recipients of optional or mandatory SSI State supplementation. Residents of Congregate Care facilities will also see an increase in their Personal Needs Allowance (PNA).

The attached SSI and SSP Benefit Levels Chart for 2015 reflect the 1.7% federal COLA increase and the statutory change noted above. The chart is provided as a resource for informational purposes. The chart can also be viewed on CentraPort under Desk Guides and on the OTDA Intranet site in the Center for Employment and Economic Supports section under Desk Guides/Aids. The increase in RSDI or SSI income for Temporary Assistance (TA) and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients will be addressed by the annual Mass Rebudgeting scheduled as follows: initial phase runs on November 8; final phase runs on November 15 and CNS letters will be produced November 17. Updated ABEL calculations will be available beginning November 9, 2014.

The 2015 Medicare Part B Premium amount will be \$104.90, the same as it was in 2014. Those individuals who filed an individual tax return in 2013 with a yearly income of \$85,000 or less and couples who filed a joint tax return with a yearly income of \$170,000 or less will pay \$104.90 in 2015 for a Part B premium. Those individuals who filed an individual tax return in 2013 with a yearly income above \$85,000 and up to \$107,000 or couples who filed a joint tax return with a yearly income above \$170,000 and up to \$107,000 or couples who filed a joint tax return with a yearly income above \$170,000 and up to \$214,000 will pay \$146.90 in 2015.
