This is a follow-up to GIS 15 TA/DC002 and GIS 15 TA/DC003, which provided information on SNAP applications submitted through Intuit (Turbo Tax).

OTDA has learned that Intuit is now directing customers that their software has determined to be potentially eligible for SNAP after completing a prescreening on their "Benefit Assist" website to OTDA's *myBenefits* account creation screen. Users outside New York City may set up an account on *myBenefits* and apply for SNAP online through *myBenefits*, which will enable local social services districts to process these SNAP applications through *myWorkspace*. For New York City residents, since the *myBenefits* account creation screen requires the user to select which county they live in, if NYC is selected, *myBenefits* will automatically redirect the NYC user to ACCESS NYC.
