The purpose of this message is to inform social services districts (districts) that as of May 1, 2018, the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) SAVE program will no longer process mailed paper submissions of the form G-845S (Document Verification Request). All verification requests must be submitted electronically starting May 1, 2018. Any paper G-845S forms received by the USCIS after that date will be returned to the sender without a response.

To process an electronic third step request, districts must submit photocopies (front and back) of the applicant/recipient's relevant immigration documents electronically using the "Scan and Upload" function in the SAVE system. Districts should receive a response within 3-5 business days.
