The purpose of the GIS message is to inform social services districts (districts) that the <u>LDSS-3152</u>: "Action Taken on Your Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits Case" and <u>LDSS-3152 NYC</u>: "Action Taken on Your Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits Case (NYC) notices, have been revised (Rev. 9/18).

Both the LDSS-3152 and LDSS-3152-NYC notices have been revised on Page 1, under "Overpayment Information". The second checkbox and sentences "You currently have a SNAP benefits overpayment. If your case is closing, see the Demand Letter and Repayment Agreement for more information on the amount you owe and how you will repay this overpayment" have been deleted. **A new sentence has been added** "In the future, if your case is closed, you will receive a separate notice providing repayment options and guidelines to ensure paying back the remaining balance. You will have 30 days from the date you receive the notice to make arrangements for repayment of the remaining balance."

The LDSS-3152 has been revised on Page 1 under "Denied" by removing the fourth line of "Name and Reason" to align with the LDSS-3152NYC. Both notices now have three lines to list the names of individual members of the household being Denied SNAP benefits.

The LDSS-3152NYC has been revised on Page 1 under "Approved", #7 "Animal Population Control Program (APCP)". Information has been updated to advise that, in this program, eligible people can have their cat or dog spayed/neutered for "free or low cost", and "to schedule an appointment near you, call (877) SPAY-NYC".

Additionally, this GIS serves as directive for the LDSS-3152 (Rev. 4/18) and LDSS-3152 NYC (Rev. 4/18).
