Homeless Housing and Assistance Corporation (HHAC) Annual Performance Report

Fiscal Year 2016-17

In accordance with Public Authorities Law (PAL), HHAC adopted the performance measures listed below in May 2010.

- 1) HHAC will administer the Homeless Housing and Assistance Program (HHAP) in as an efficient manner as possible in order to achieve the statutory intent of the program, as measured by the number of housing units (or beds) funded and which become operational annually.
- 2) HHAC will monitor contract compliance as measured by the degree to which funded homeless projects are compliant with the following aspects which are specified in the grant agreement:
- a. Housing the appropriate homeless population;
- b. Providing support services, as required; and
- c. Properly maintaining the project premises.

PAL further stipulates that a performance report be prepared annually and posted on the Authority's website. Accordingly, performance data indicated below demonstrates that HHAC's administration of HHAP is in conformity with the statutory intent to increase and maintain the supply of supportive housing for the homeless.

- 1) In State Fiscal Year 2016-17, 531 units consisting of 1,092 beds became operational.
- 2) a) Documentation of homelessness was verified in 86% of monitoring visits conducted.
- b) The Management and Operating Plan (MOP), including support services plans were satisfactory and being implemented in 73% of monitoring visits conducted.
- c) Fair or poor property conditions were noted in 15% of monitoring visits conducted.
