Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

SEPTEMBER 2004

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 627,331 in September 2004, decreasing by 4,042 (-0.6%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$152,706,728 in September 2004 decreasing approximately \$5.4 million (-3.4%) over August 2004.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,683,379 in September 2004, increasing by 32,646 (+2.0%) over August 2004. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$162,974,264 in September 2004, increasing approximately \$1.2 million (+0.8%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For September 2004, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 632,493 increasing 332 (+0.1%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in September totaled \$304,500,755 decreasing approximately \$1.4 million (-0.4%) from August 2004.

Aggregate Claims

Aggregate Claims: This month's *Temporary and Disability Statistics* contains new data on aggregate local district claims for Temporary Assistance costs. These data are included pursuant to legislative mandate, and are described in notes accompanying the data tables.

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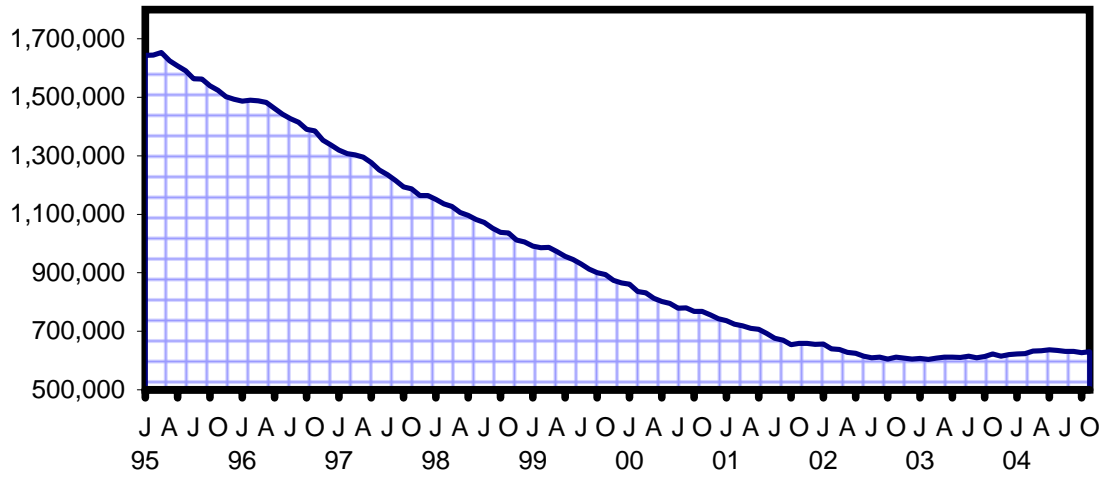
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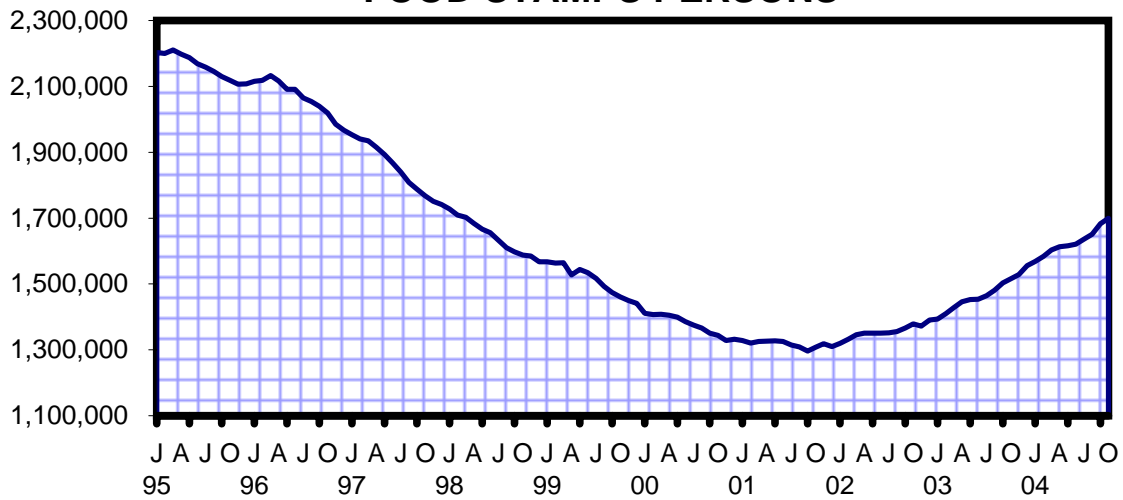

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

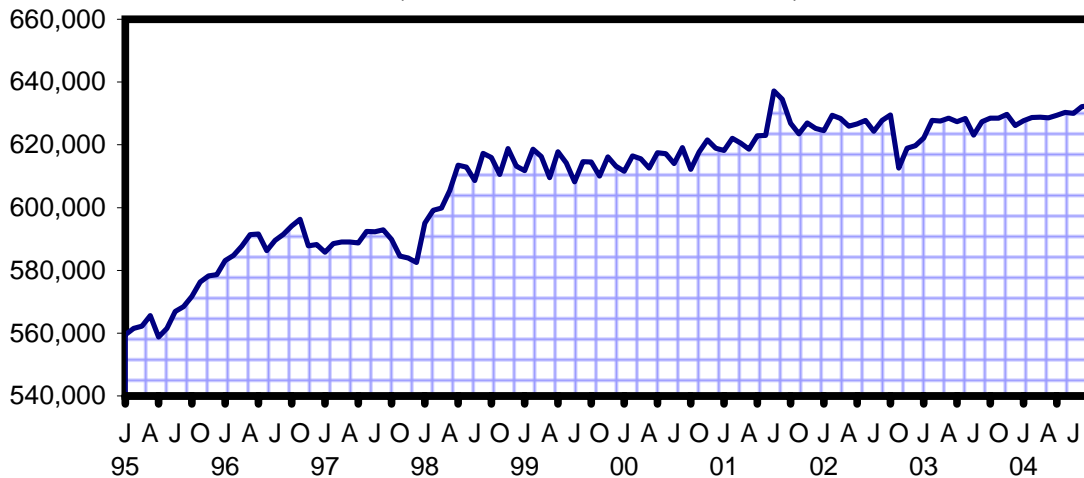


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
