Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

NOVEMBER 2004

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 622,728 in November 2004, decreasing by 7,575 (-1.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$153,824,438 in November 2004 decreasing \$426,956 (-0.3%) over October 2004.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,716,699 in November 2004, increasing by 16,716 (+1.0%) over October 2004. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$177,048,476 in November 2004, increasing \$526,856 (+0.3%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For November 2004, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 634,709 increasing 5,260 (+0.8%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in November totaled \$310,640,436 decreasing approximately \$7.6 million (+2.5%) from October 2004.

Aggregate Claims

Aggregate Claims: This month's *Temporary and Disability Statistics* contains new data on aggregate local district claims for Temporary Assistance costs. These data are included pursuant to legislative mandate, and are described in notes accompanying the data tables.

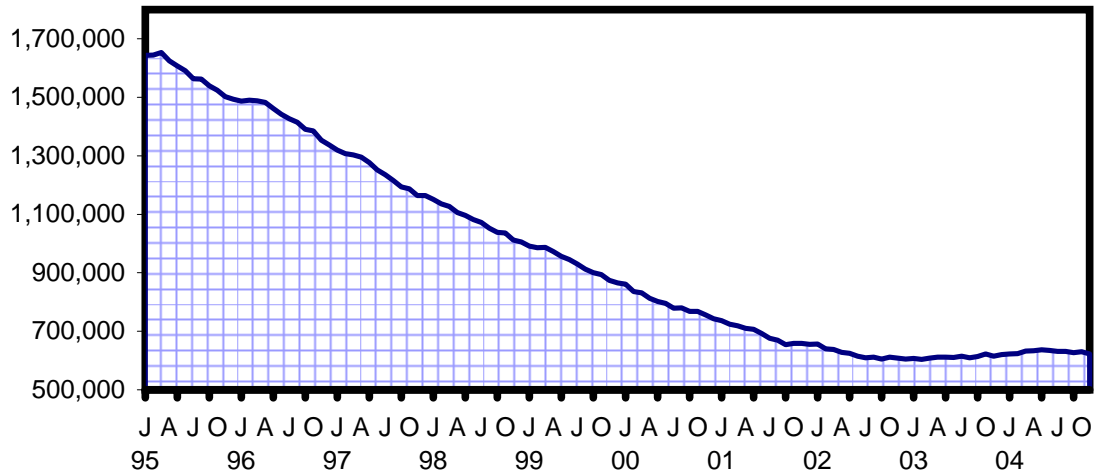

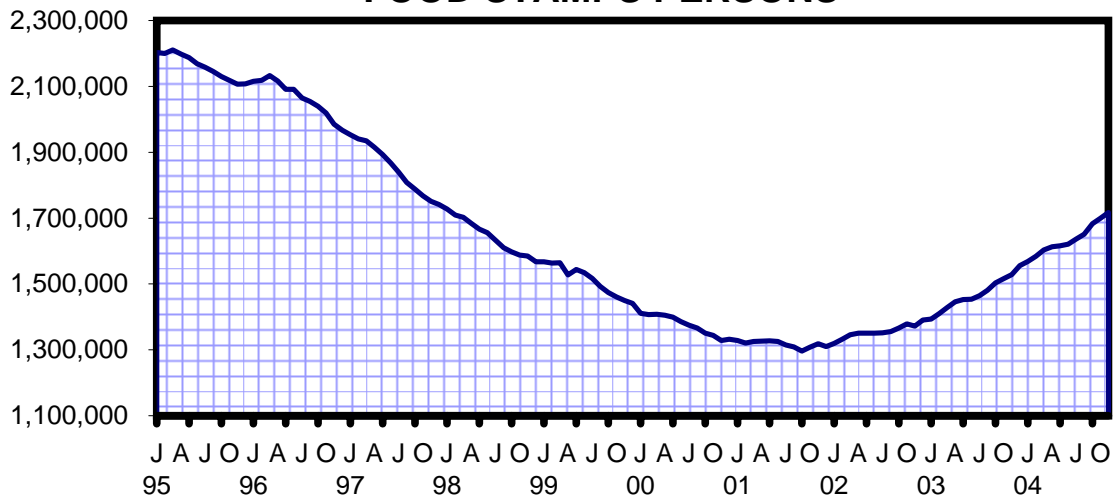

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

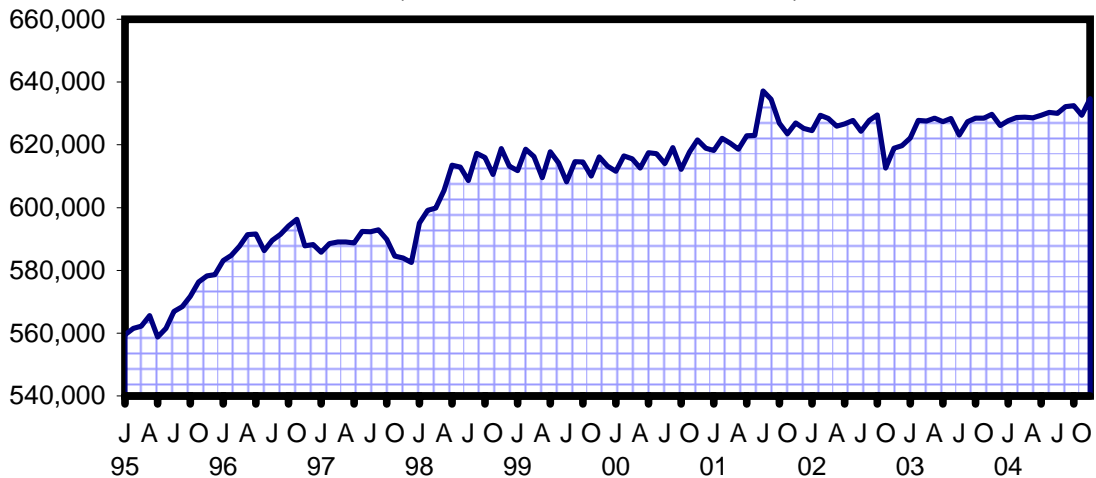


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
