Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics JANUARY 2007

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 550,881 in January 2007, decreasing by 4,117 (-0.7%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$151,667,990 in January 2007 decreasing by approximately \$3.2 million (-2.1%) over December 2006.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,802,101 in January 2007, increasing by 2,641 (+0.1%) over December 2006. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$193,766,970 in January 2007, decreasing approximately \$3.4 million (-1.7%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For January 2007, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 644,692 increasing 741 (+0.1%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in January totaled \$332,494,160 increasing approximately \$11.2 million (+3.5%) from December 2006.

Note: It was recently determined that the number of Temporary Assistance Cases, Recipients and Expenditures for the Rest of State Districts of Fulton, Livingston, St. Lawrence and Schuyler was understated on prior publications of the October 2006 Temporary and Disability Statistics. The proper caseload data contained in this revision of January 2007 affects October 2006 Rest of State recipient data displayed on Tables 21 thru 23.

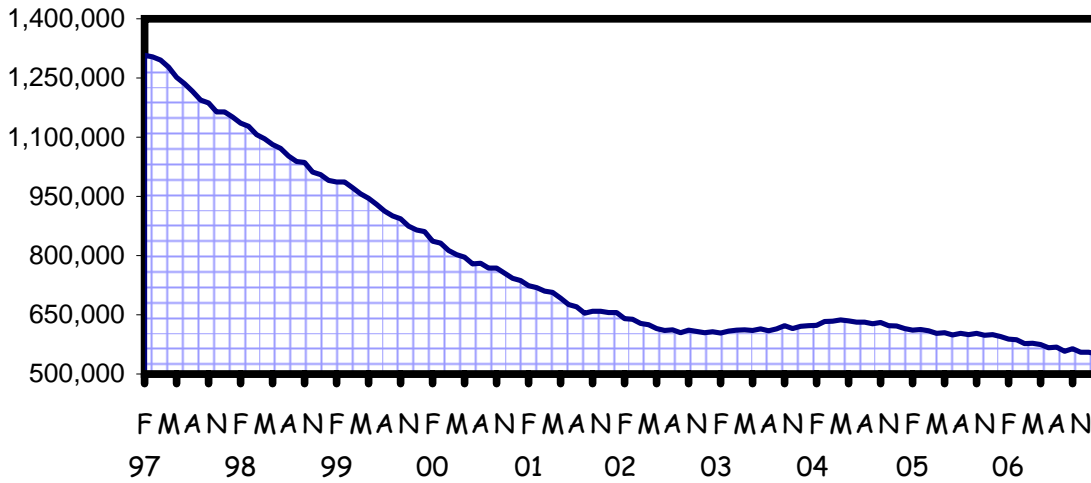

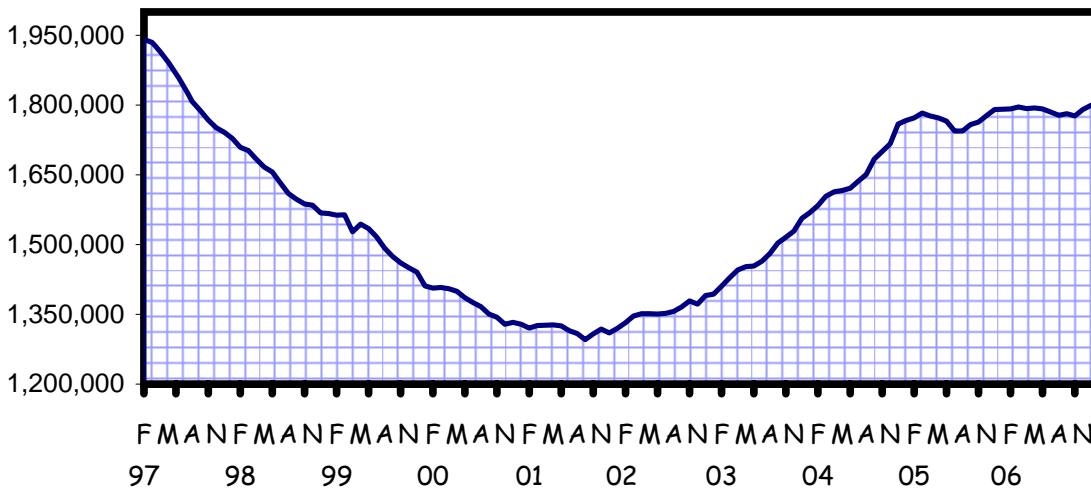

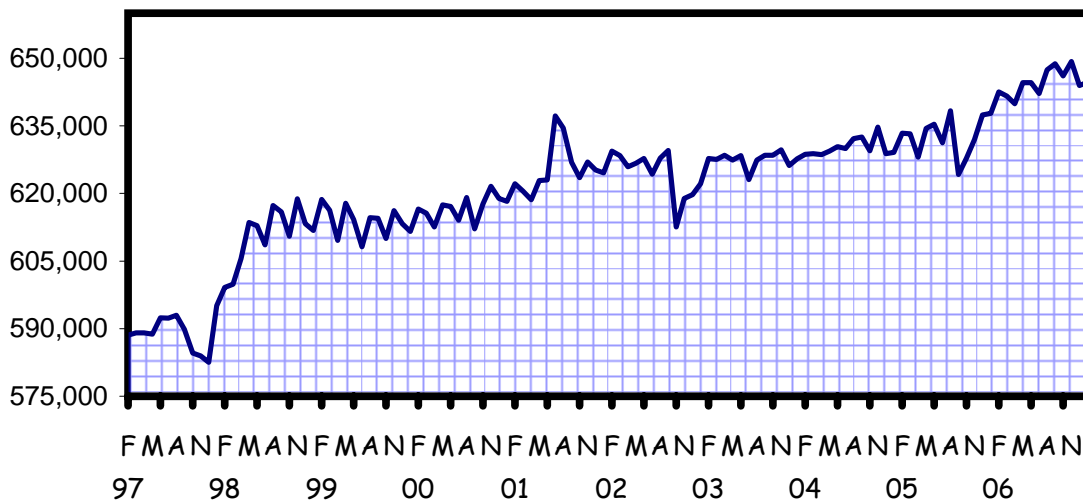


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
