Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 527,243 in July 2007, decreasing by 4,064 (-0.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$145,024,781 in July 2007 decreasing by approximately \$4.6 million (-3.1%) over June 2007.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,792,916 in July 2007, decreasing by 8,791 (-0.5%) over June 2007. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$193,768,696 in July 2007, decreasing by \$662,045 (-0.3%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For July 2007, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 646,873 decreasing 2,287 (-0.4%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in July totaled \$336,698,862 decreasing by approximately \$2.2 million (-0.6%) from June 2007.

NOTICE

This month a systems adjustment was applied in New York City to help ensure proper categorization of cases across funding categories. This adjustment has the effect of shifting cases from the Safety Net Non-Maintenance of Effort category into the Family Assistance and Safety Net Maintenance of Effort categories. This shift should be kept in mind when assessing month-to-month changes within specific case categories.

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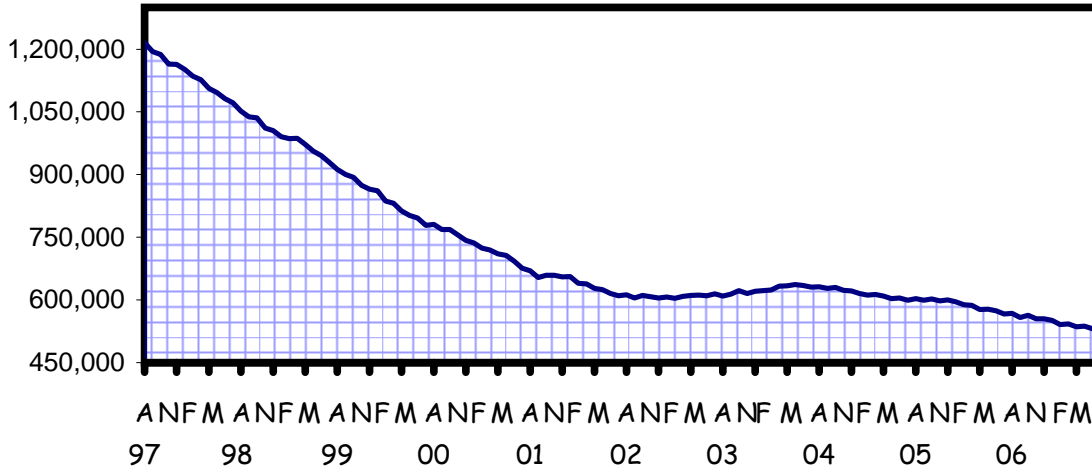
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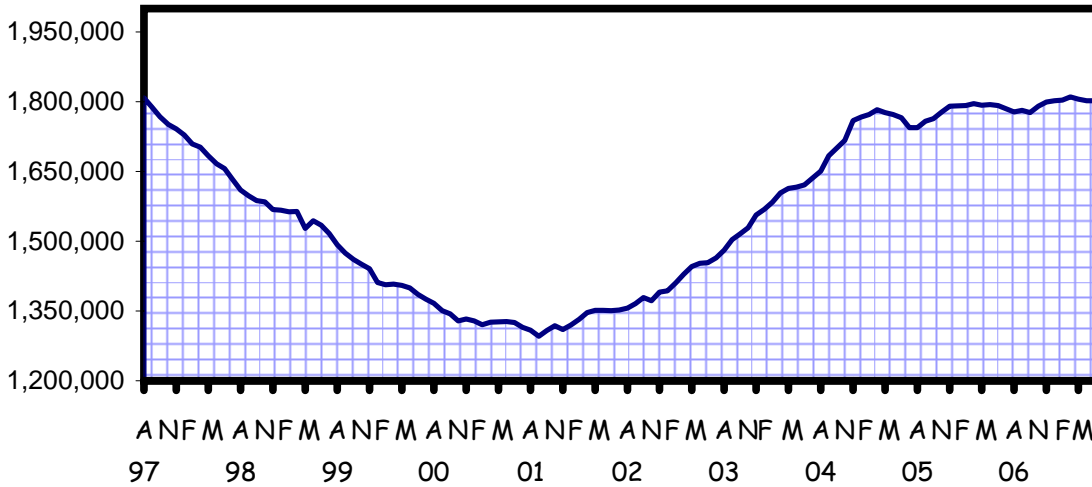

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS**

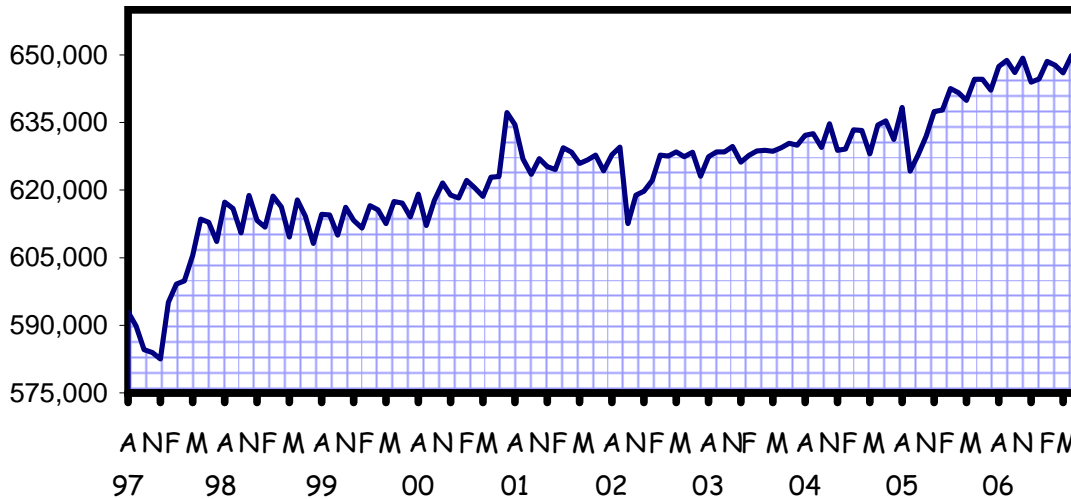


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
