Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

DECEMBER 2008

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 514,382 in December 2008, increasing by 9,283 (+1.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$166,698,833 in December 2008 increasing by approximately \$16.8 million (+11.2%) over November 2008.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,174,325 in December 2008, increasing by 37,219 (+1.7%) over November 2008. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$279,788,183 in December 2008, increasing by approximately \$5.4 million (+2.0%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For December 2008, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 660,704 decreasing by 2,396 (-0.4%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in December totaled \$358,130,950 increasing by approximately \$4.7 million (+1.3%) from November 2008.

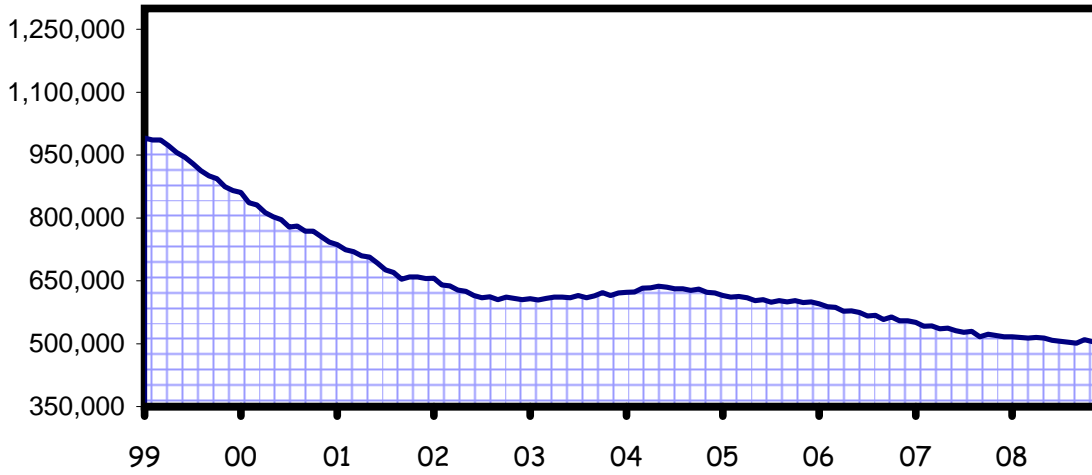
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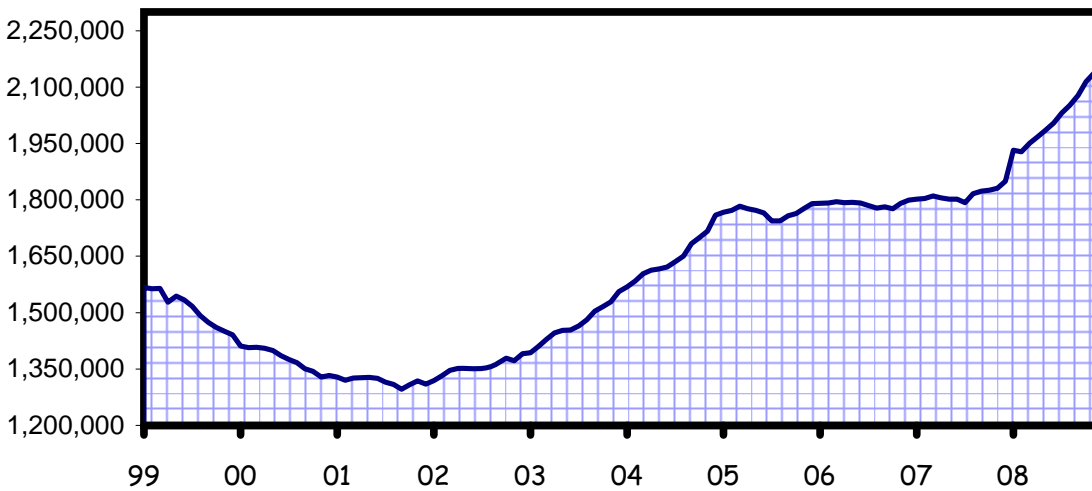
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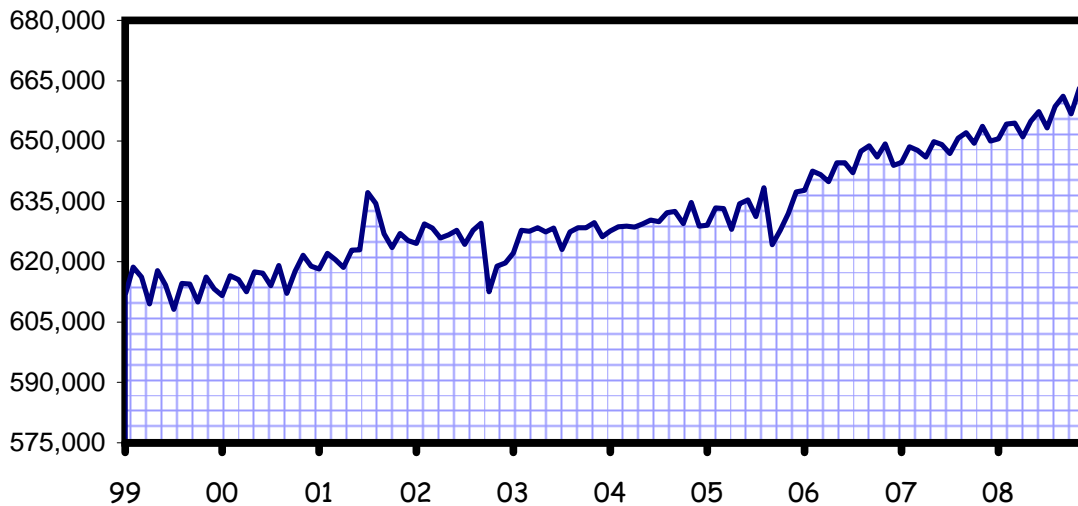
