Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 546,348 in January 2010, decreasing by 7,057 (-1.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$168,633,431 in January 2010, decreasing by approximately \$11.7 million (-6.5%) over December 2009.

Reporting Change Note: Beginning this month, New York City Family Assistance (FA) counts will no longer contain Emergency Assistance for Families (EAF) case, recipient and expenditure counts, as had been previous practice. This change will make New York City figures comparable to those for the rest of the state, where EAF is not counted. This change will affect statewide and New York City counts in all table columns containing FA counts (Tables 1 through 5 total TA counts, Table 6 FA-FP counts, Table 8 total and federally participating counts, and Table 9 FA-FP counts). In each case, the reporting change will reduce the affected counts from what they would have been in the absence of the change by 1,440 cases, 3,729 persons, 1,908 children and 1,821 adults. Associated expenditures were \$3,268,031. Changes from previous periods should be interpreted in this context. Also, statewide and New York City recipient counts in Aggregate Claims Tables 21 and 22 will be affected, but for January only. Net expenditures on Tables 21 and 22 are not affected by this change.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,699,586 in January 2010, increasing by 26,443 (+1.0%) over December 2009. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$413,386,703 in January 2010, increasing by approximately \$6.7 million (+1.6%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For January 2010, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 668,783, decreasing by 3,652 (-0.5%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in January 2010 totaled \$373,529,093 decreasing by approximately \$8.2 million (-2.1%) from December 2009.

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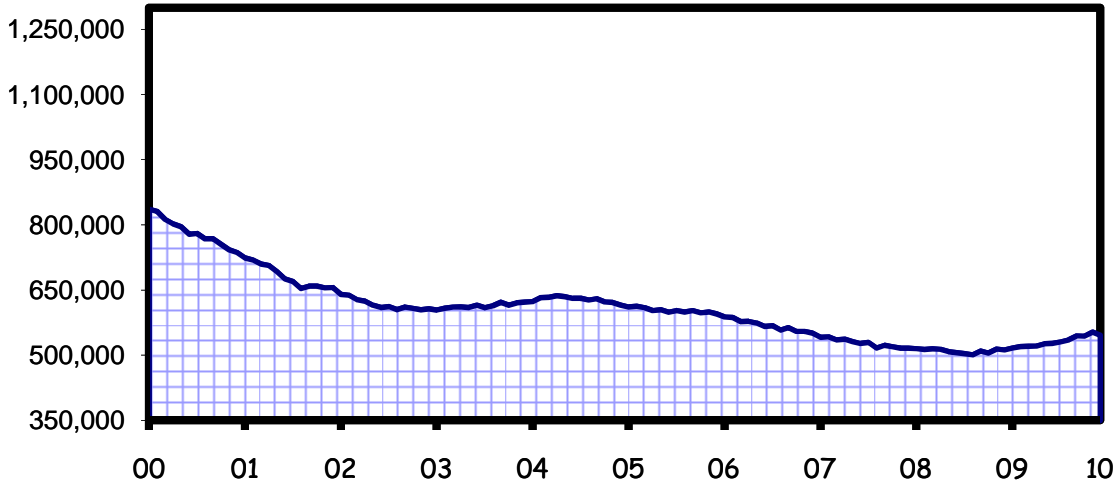
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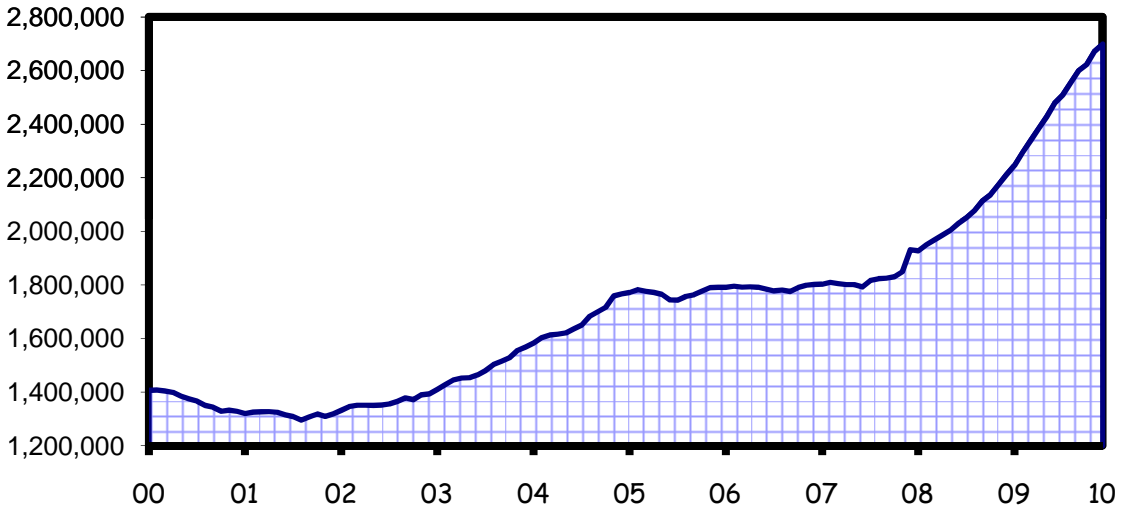
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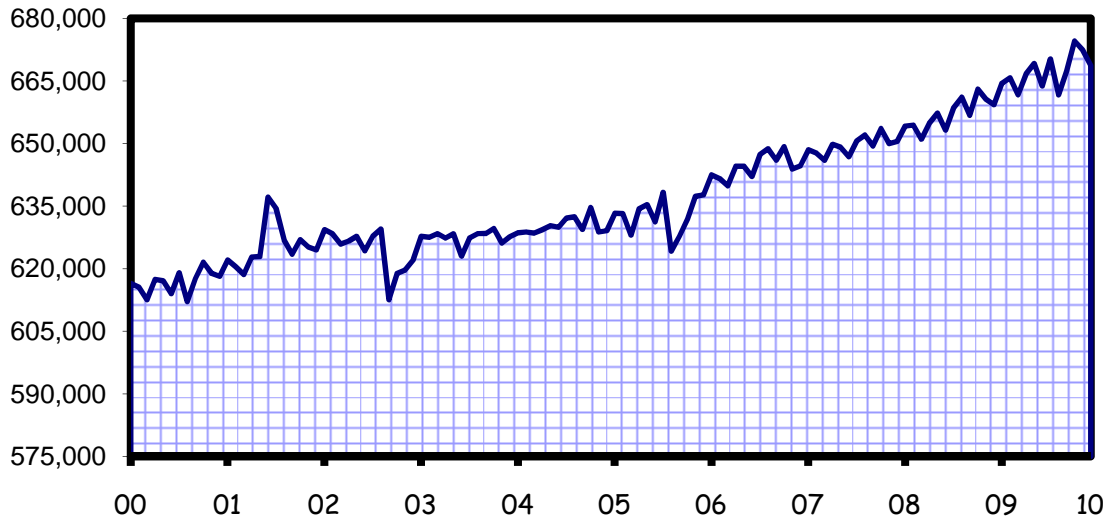
