Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 543,003 in June 2010, increasing by 2,297 (+0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$174,912,731 in June 2010, increasing by approximately \$7.8 million (+4.7%) over May 2010.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,824,845 in June 2010, increasing by 25,111 (+0.9%) over May 2010. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$427,512,154 in June 2010, increasing by approximately \$3.6 million (+0.8%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For June 2010, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 666,720 decreasing by 11,844 (-1.7 %) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in June 2010 totaled \$375,905,561 decreasing by approximately \$8.4 million (-2.2%) from May 2010.

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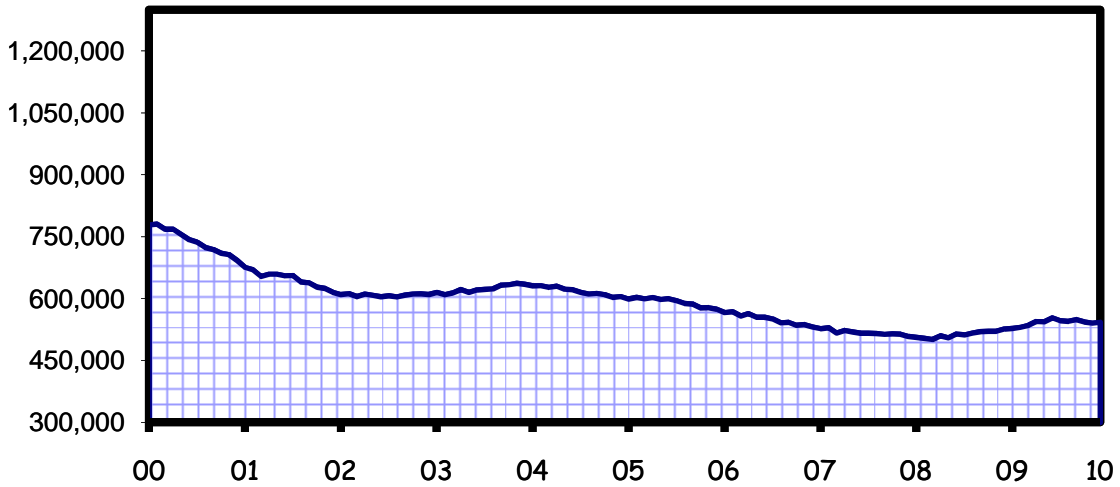
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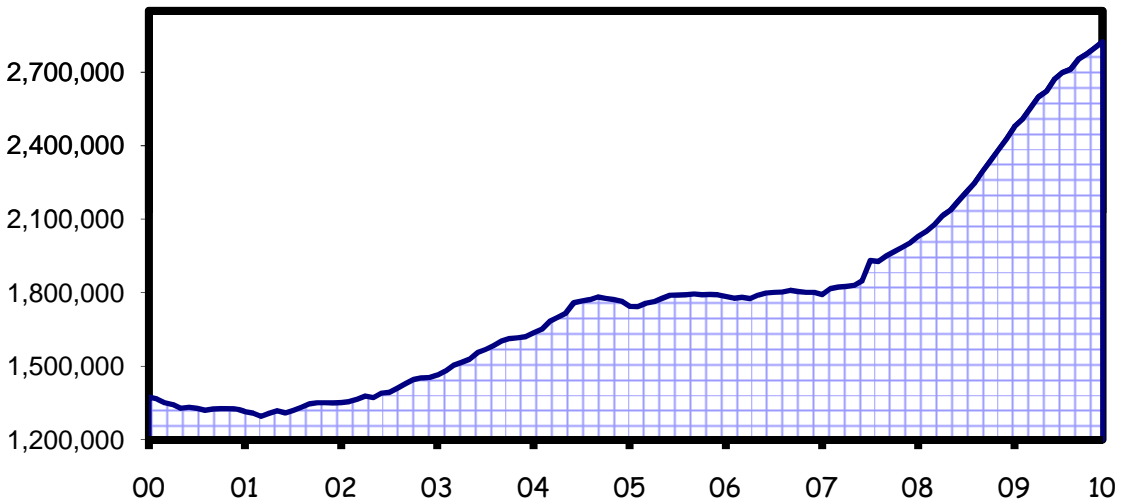
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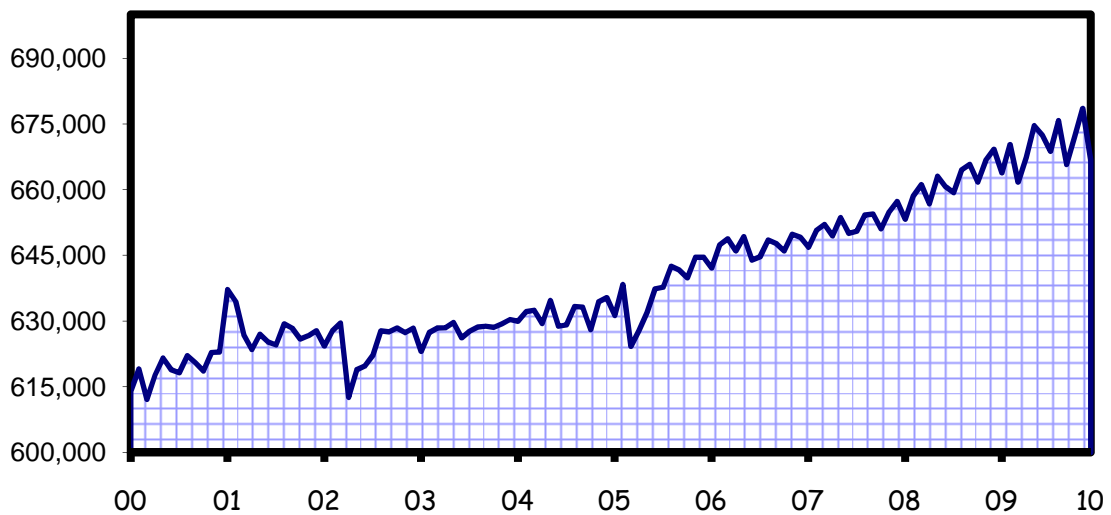
