Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **NOVEMBER 2011**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 564,341 in November 2011, decreasing by 1,709 (-0.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$173,265,517 in November 2011, decreasing by approximately \$2.1 million (-1.2%) over October 2011.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Food Stamp recipients totaled 3,046,972 in November 2011, decreasing by 13,135 (-0.4%) from the previous month. Food Stamp expenditures totaled \$459,862,827 in November 2011, decreasing by approximately 7.6 million (-1.6%) over October 2011.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For November 2011, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 696,894 increasing by 5,333 (+0.8%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in November 2011 totaled \$393,696,585 increasing by approximately \$7.9 million (+2.1%) over October 2011.

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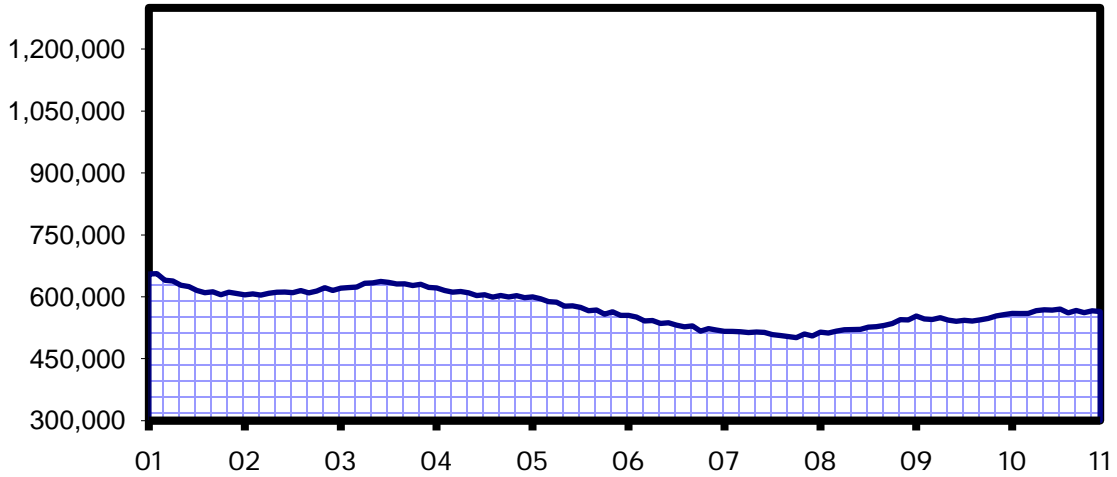
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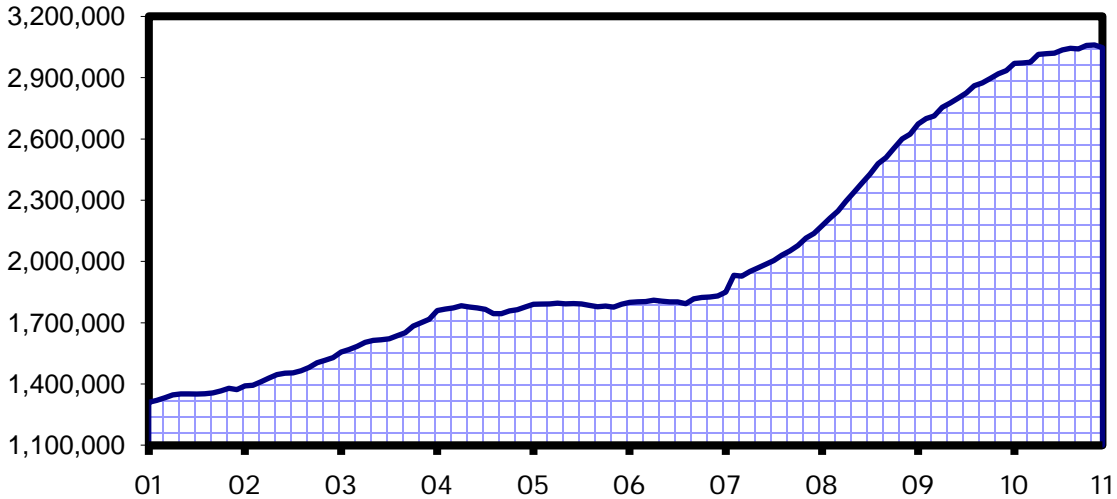
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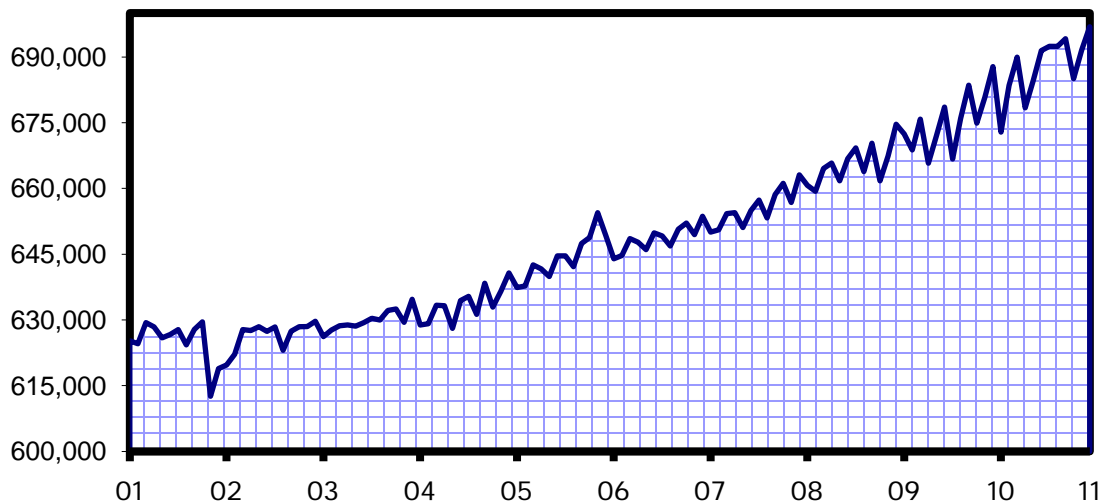
