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# Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **DECEMBER 2011**

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## Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 570,772 in December 2011, increasing by 6,431 (+1.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$180,459,357 in December 2011, increasing by approximately \$7.2 million (+4.2%) over November 2011.

## Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Food Stamp recipients totaled 3,068,575 in December 2011, increasing by 21,603 (+0.7%) from the previous month. Food Stamp expenditures totaled \$460,202,319 in December 2011, increasing by 339,492 approximately (+0.07%) over November 2011.

## Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For December 2011, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 693,283 decreasing by 3,611 (-0.5%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in December 2011 totaled \$387,949,844 decreasing by approximately \$5.8 million (-1.5%) over November 2011.

Due to unforeseen difficulties in implementing changes to the Automated Claiming System, some districts were unable to enter claiming data previous to the due date for this publication. Therefore, November and December claims in the Aggregate Claims Tables 21 through 24 will have incomplete data. Previous months have been updated to reflect the most current information available.

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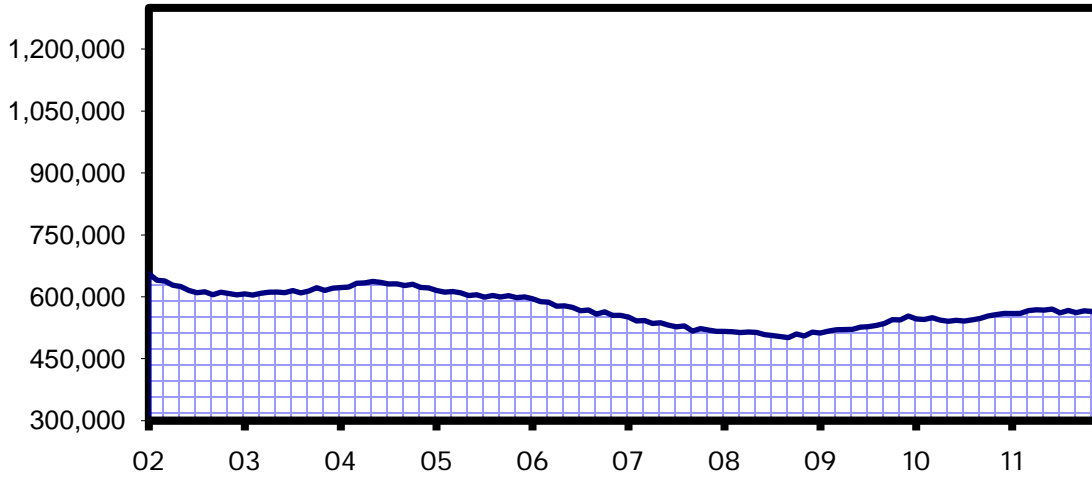
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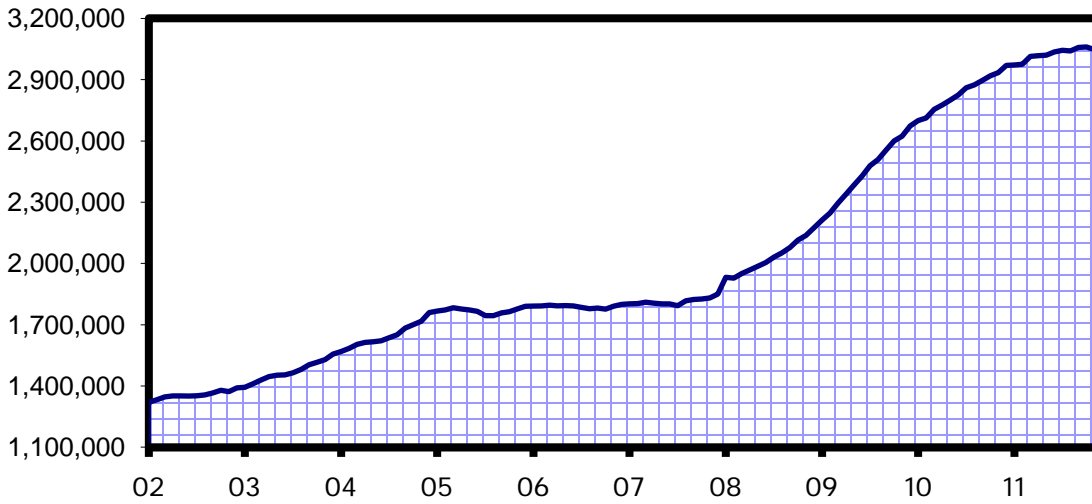
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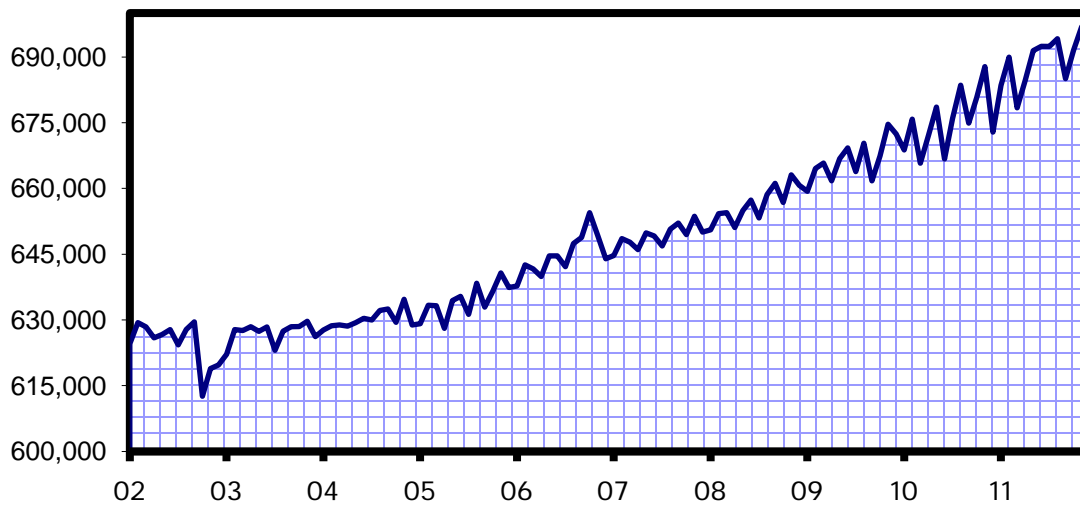
