Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **MARCH 2012**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 572,757 in March 2012, increasing by 5,623 (+1.0%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$184,011,703 in March 2012, increasing by approximately \$7.2 million (+4.1%) over February 2012.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Food Stamp recipients totaled 3,081,831 in March 2012, increasing by 22,569 (+0.74%) from the previous month. Food Stamp expenditures totaled \$461,998,933 in March 2012, increasing by approximately \$8.2 million (+1.8%) over February 2012.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For March 2012, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 684,992 decreasing by 11,493 (-1.7%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in March 2012 totaled \$393,337,738 decreasing by approximately \$8.5 million (-2.1%) over February 2012.

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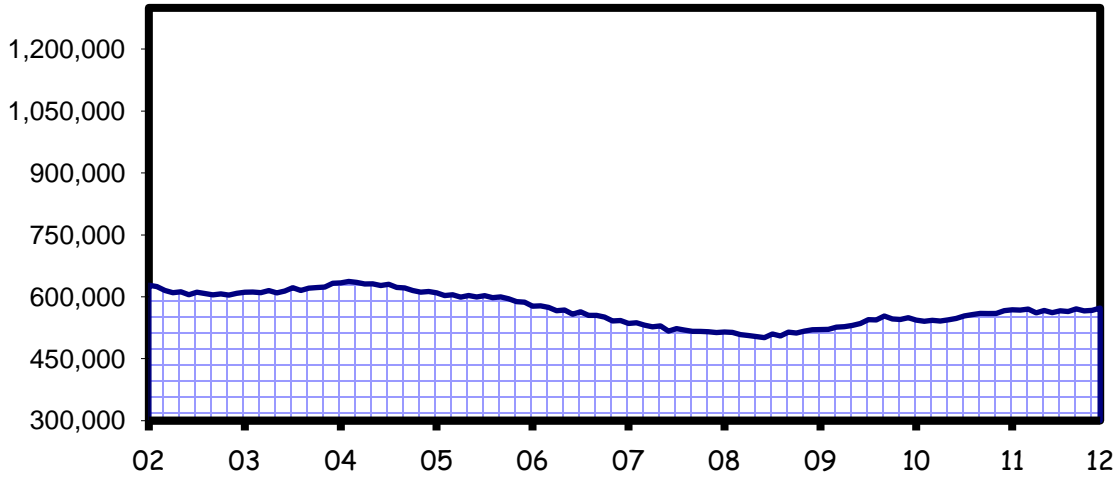
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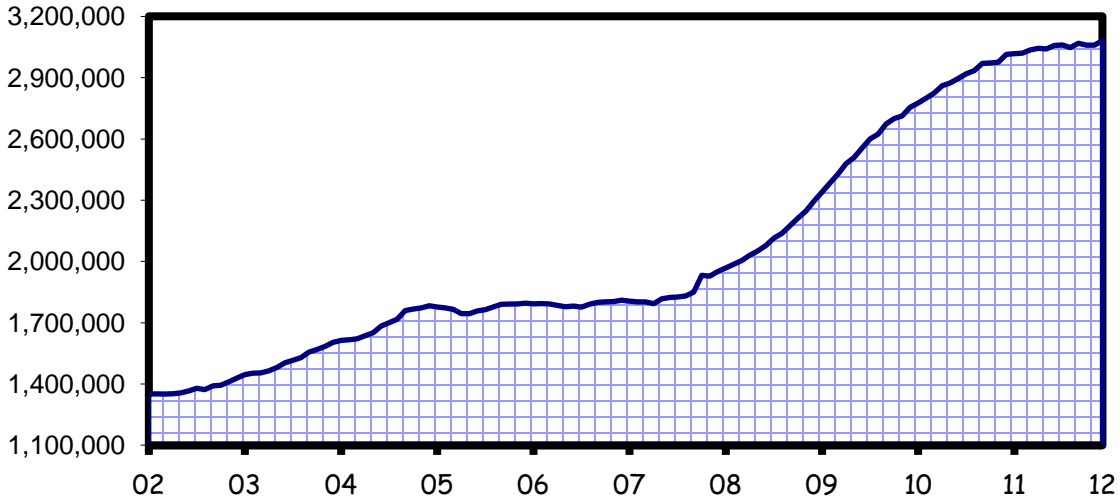
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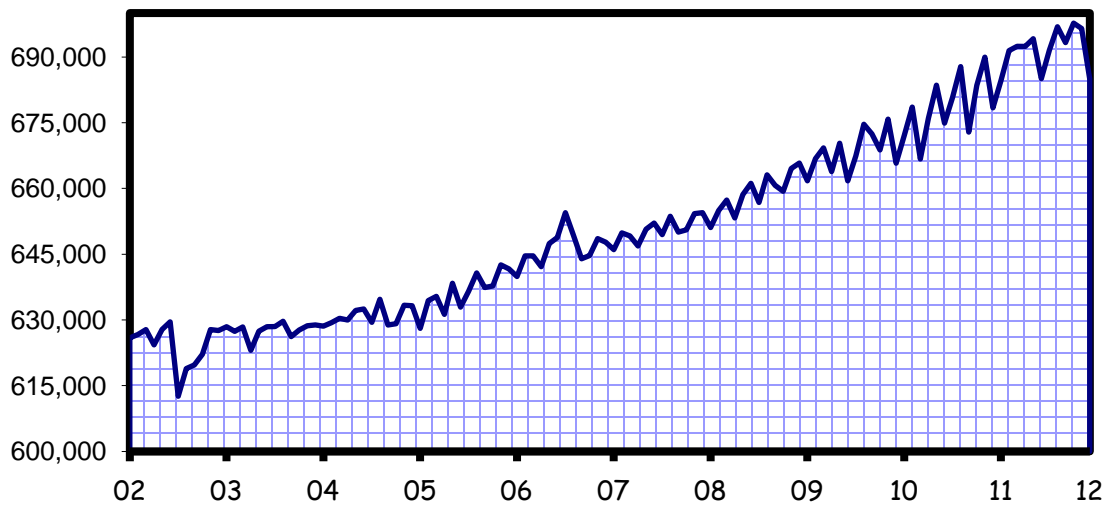
