Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **JULY 2012**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 564,427 in July 2012, decreasing by 5,201 (-0.9%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$175,757,878 in July 2012, decreasing by approximately \$1.4 million (-0.8%) over June 2012.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,094,677 in July 2012, decreasing by 857 (-0.03%) from the previous month. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program expenditures totaled \$457,029,425 in July 2012, decreasing by \$488,816 (-0.1%) over June 2012.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For July 2012, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 695,554 increasing by 10,087 (+1.5%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in July 2012 totaled \$401,558,531 increasing by approximately \$9.96 million (+2.5%) over June 2012.

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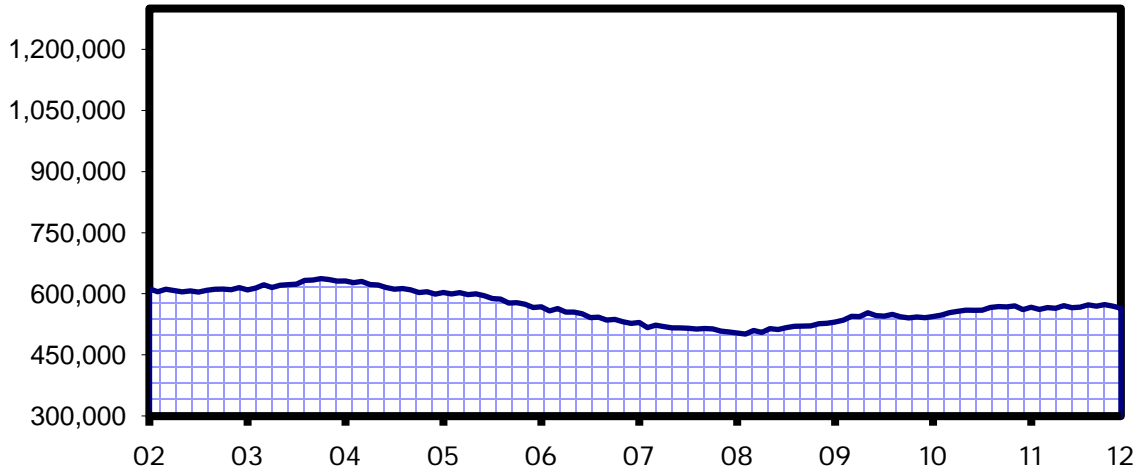
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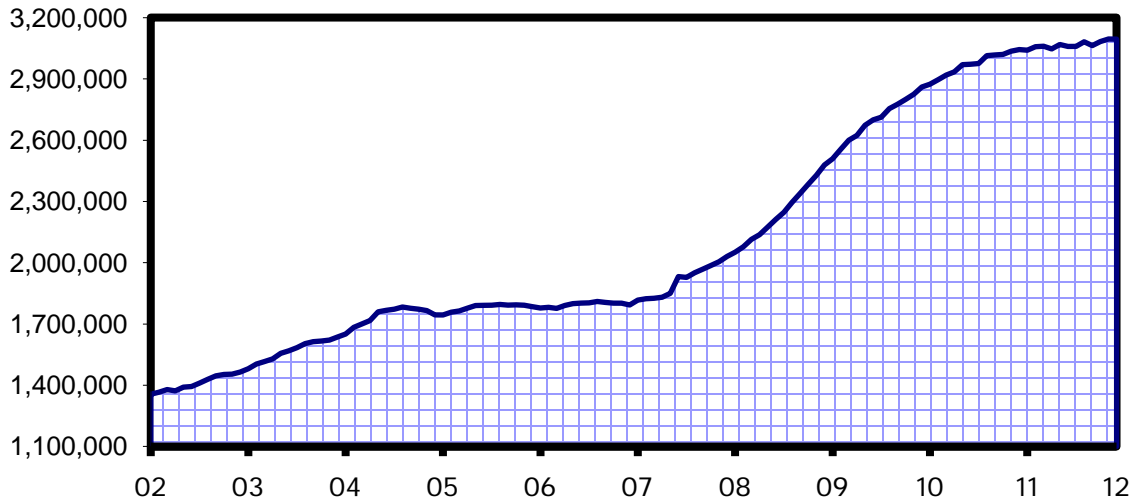
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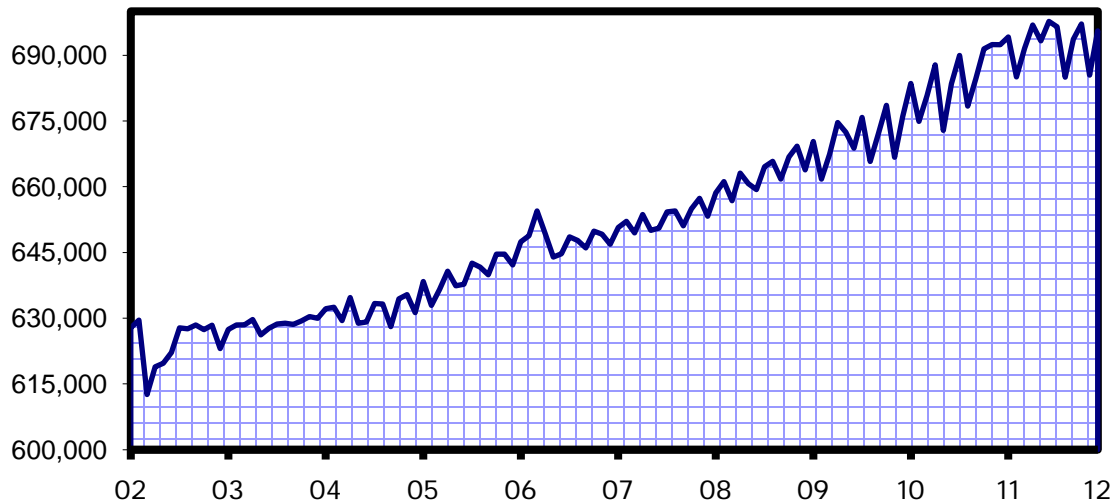
