Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **NOVEMBER 2012**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 571,304 in November 2012, decreasing by 1,764 (-0.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$181,483,513 in November 2012, decreasing by approximately \$5.6 million (-3.0%) over October 2012.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,152,122 in November 2012, increasing by 42,052 (+1.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$546,569,079 in November 2012, increasing by approximately \$86.2 million (+18.7%) over October 2012.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 702,063 in November 2012, increasing by 2,746 (+0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$401,772,625 in November 2012, decreasing by approximately \$1.05 million (-0.3%) over October 2012.

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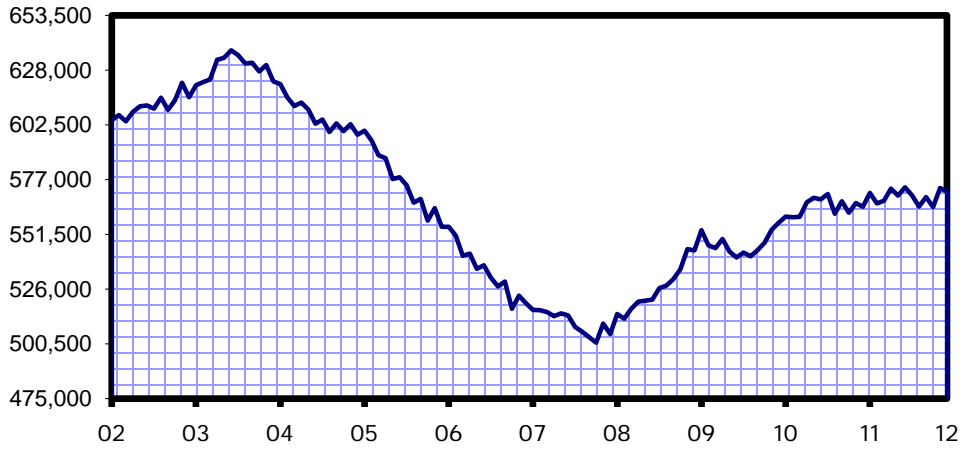
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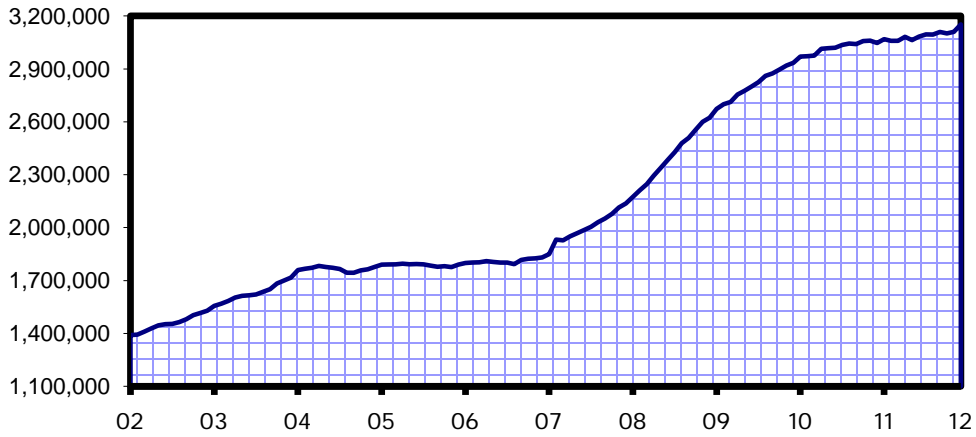

TEN YEAR TREND**

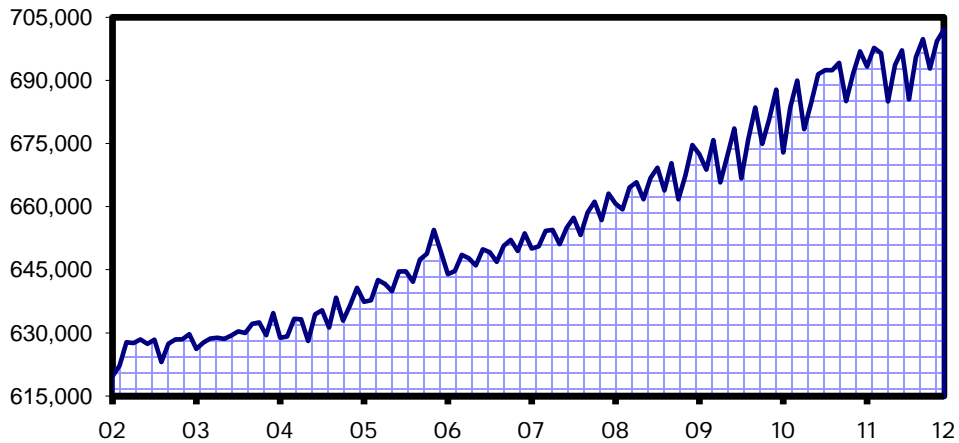
Temporary Assistance Recipients
