AUGUST 2013

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 573,835 in August 2013, decreasing by 2,520 (-0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$184,064,714 in August 2013, decreasing by approximately \$2.4 million (-1.3%) over July 2013.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,186,530 in August 2013, decreasing by 7,940 (-0.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$466,181,249 in August 2013, decreasing by \$303,917 (-0.1%) over July 2013.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 703,724 in August 2013, increasing by 4,439 (+0.6%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$411,251,578 in August 2013, increasing by approximately \$2.03 million (+0.5%) over July 2013.

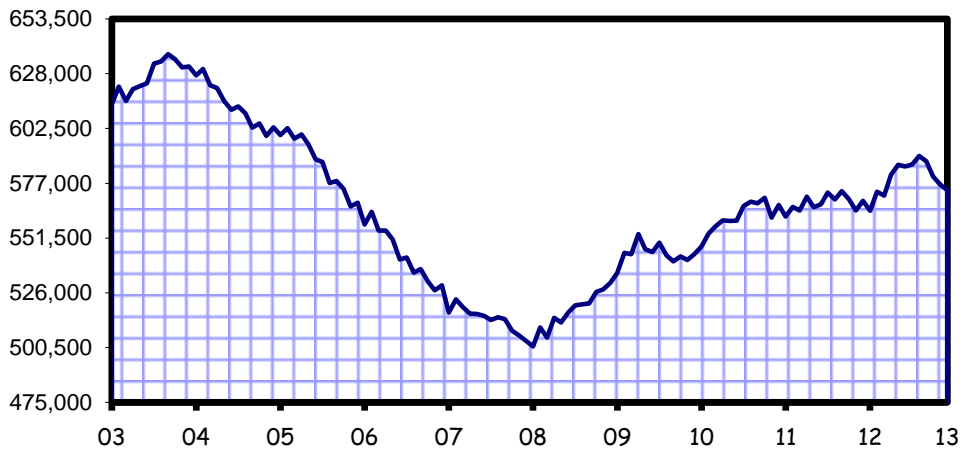

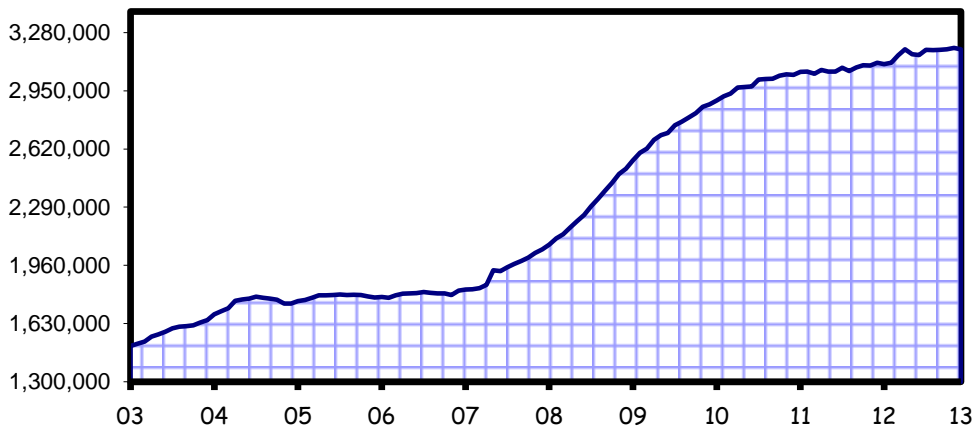

NEW YORK STATE September 2003 - August 2013 TEN YEAR TREND

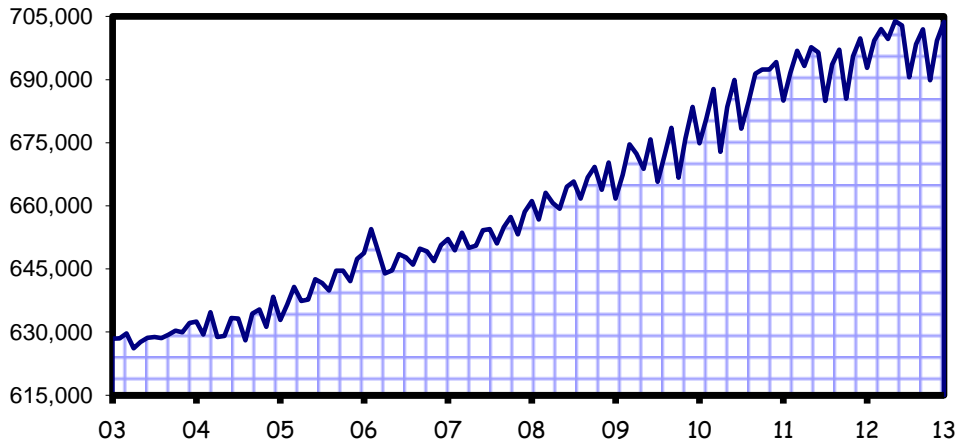
