Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 564,612 in May 2014, decreasing by 851 (-0.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$186,410,829 in May 2014, decreasing by approximately \$4.4 million (-2.3%) over April 2014.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,101,888 in May 2014, decreasing by 1,589 (-0.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$428,885,881 in May 2014, increasing by \$118,326 (+0.03%) over April 2014.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 702,654 in May 2014, increasing by 3,320 (+0.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$415,555,037 in May 2014, decreasing by \$164,601 (-0.04%) over April 2014.

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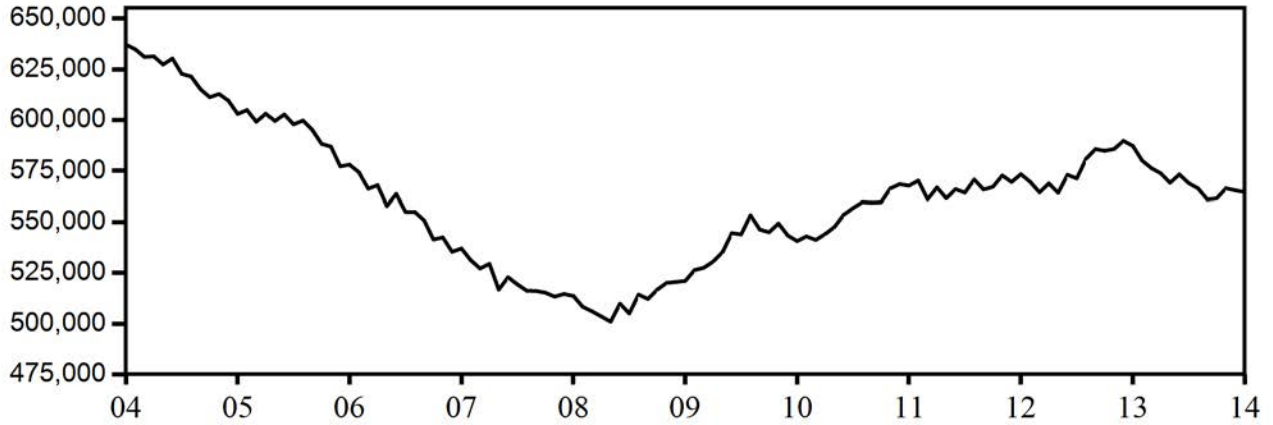
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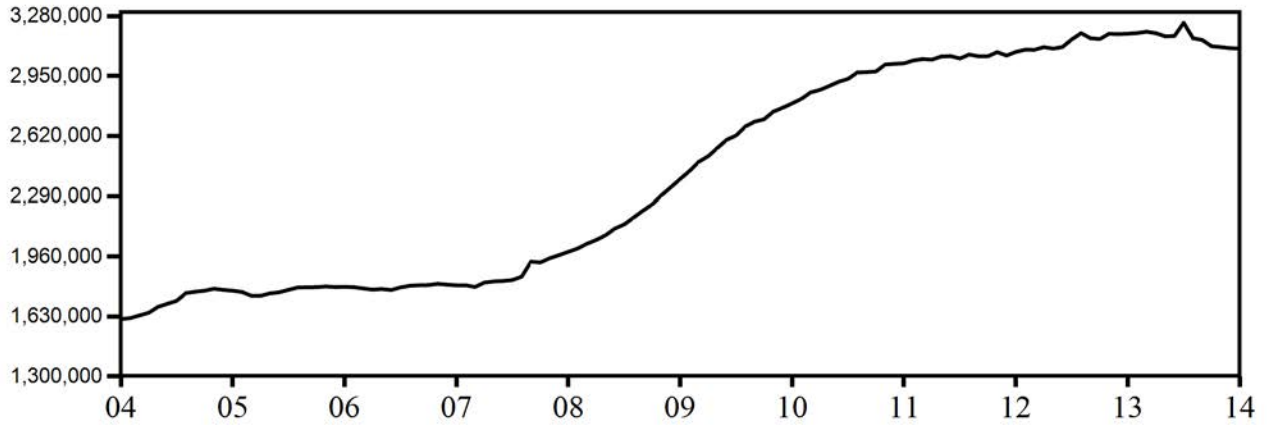

TEN YEAR TREND**

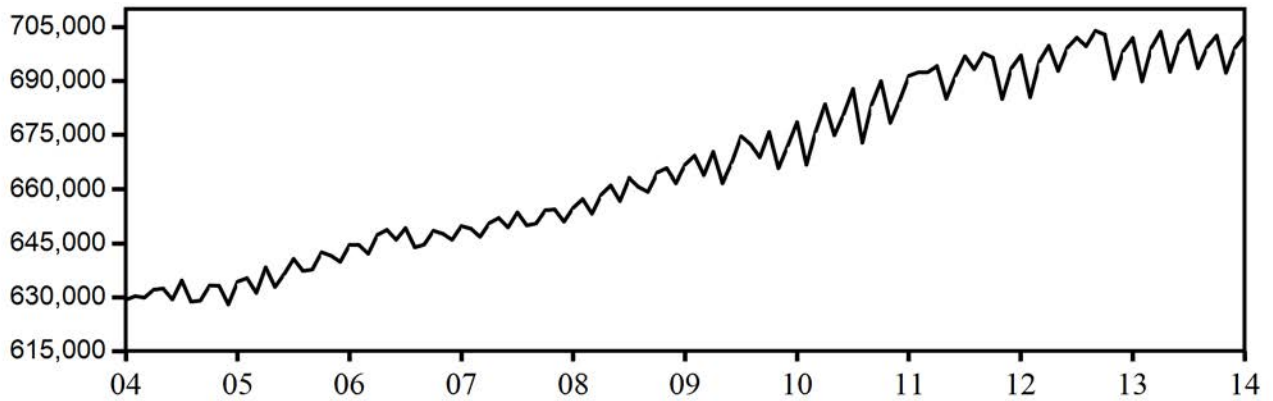
Temporary Assistance Recipients
