Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 567,809 in September 2014, increasing by 2,090 (+0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$184,603,368 in September 2014, increasing by \$399,249 (+0.2%) over August 2014.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,066,686 in September 2014, decreasing by 8,439 (-0.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$418,675,109 in September 2014, decreasing by approximately \$3.6 million (-0.9%) over August 2014.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 703,612 in September 2014, increasing by 1,934 (+0.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$416,674,450 in September 2014, increasing by approximately \$2.7 million (+0.6%) over August 2014.

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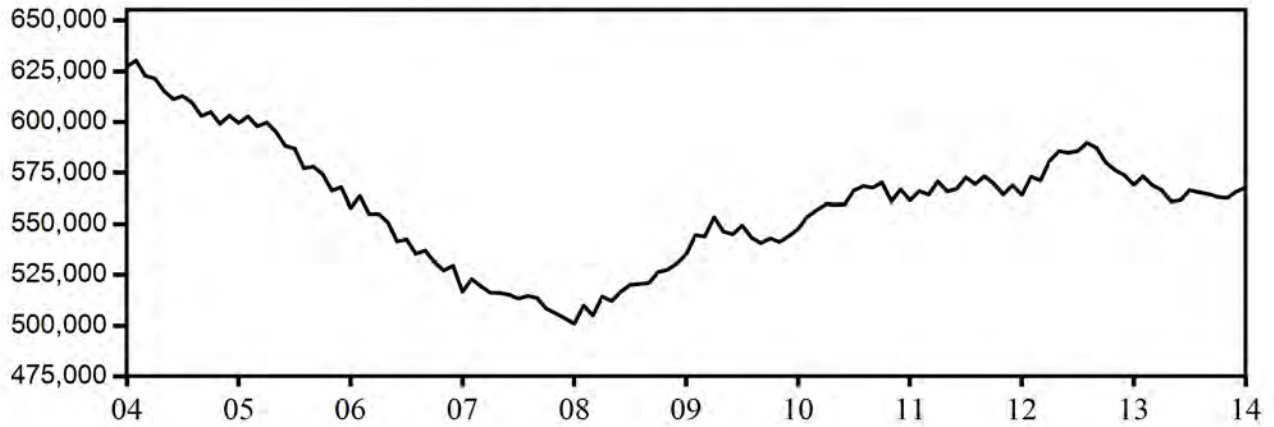
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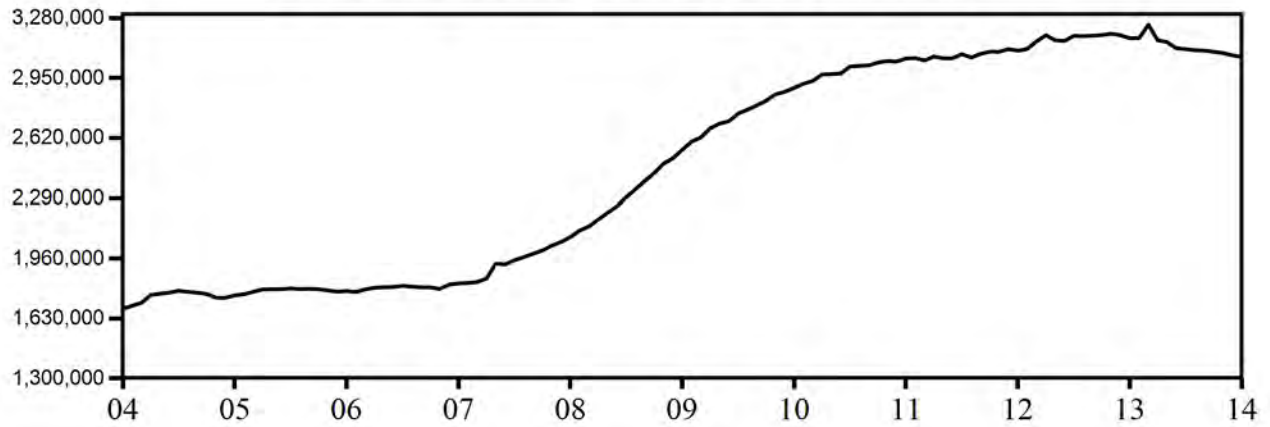

TEN YEAR TREND

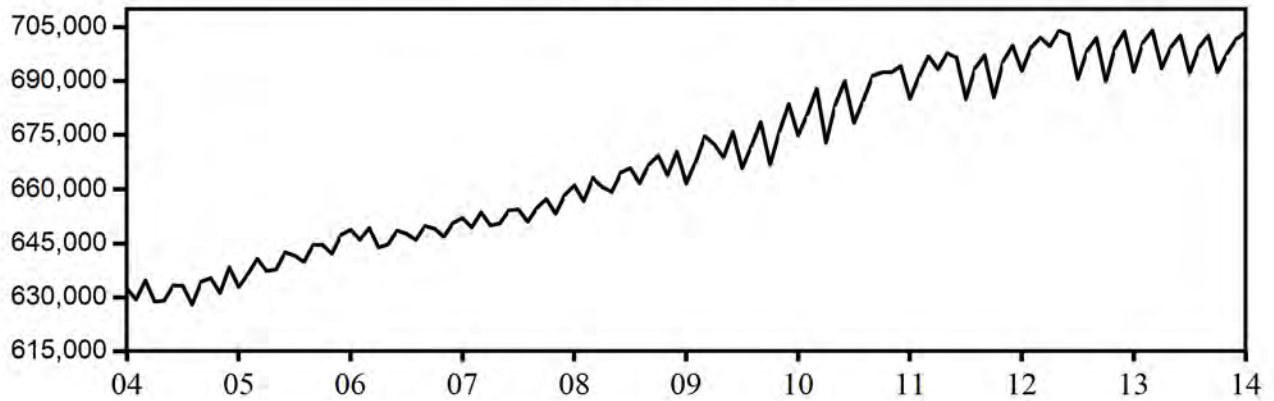
Temporary Assistance Recipients
