

Refugee School Impact Grant

Description:

The New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) through its Bureau of Refugee and Immigrant Assistance (BRIA), issues this Request for Proposals to select agencies/entities to provide and implement comprehensive education and acculturation services that assist eligible refugee school-age persons ages 5-18 *and their families* acclimate to the American schools.

Eligibility/Qualifications Requirements/Preferences

Eligible applicants include public agencies, county or municipal governments, or any subdivision; not-for-profit corporations, including charitable organizations incorporated, registered and in good standing with the charities Bureau of the Attorney General in the State of New York; and faith based organizations and educational institutions. Eligible applicants must be located in and do business in one of the five impacted counties of: Erie, Monroe, Onondaga, Oneida or Albany. OTDA intends to competitively select three applicants to provide services out of the five eligible impacted counties.

It is anticipated that this will result in three 57 month contract totaling \$3,618,151.
