Eligible Applicants

- During the Bidders' Conference Call, you mentioned that no more than one grant will be awarded in each impacted area. Will you please clarify what these areas are?
 - The impacted areas are listed in the RFP on page 17.
- Is this grant cycle open to the current grantees, as well?
 - Yes, the grant cycle is open to all eligible applicants, per page 5 of the RFP, including current grantees that continue to meet the requirements of the Grants Gateway Prequalification Application, and are located in and do business in New York.

Grant Application

- Where do I find the application?

- In the Grants Gateway Application, on the Work Plan Overview Form, I only see a place to input the Project Summary and Organizational Capacity, but not the Objectives and Tasks.
 - From the Forms Menu, under the Work Plan heading, click on Work Plan Properties. That is where you complete the Objectives and Tasks per the instructions on page 31 of the RFP.
