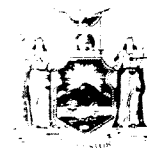

SUBJECT: Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Subsidy
Program: Reallocation

The purpose of this LCM is to inform each social services district concerning reallocation of child care subsidy funds under the federal Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act of 1990.

Social services districts were notified in 92 LCM-1 dated January 2, 1992, 92 LCM-68 dated April 21, 1992, and 92 LCM-139 dated September 8, 1992, concerning the terms and conditions for the application of and approval for participation in the CCDBG subsidy program and the amount allocated for the period beginning October 1, 1991. Districts which have submitted a Statement of Intention to Participate in the Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Subsidy Program and have received Department approval of their CCDBG Subsidy Program Plan prior to September 15, 1992 are considered to be participating.

CCDBG funds previously allocated to social services districts which elected not to participate in year one of the program have been reallocated. Attachment A - District Allocation - provides revised allocations to social services districts for the period beginning October 1, 1991. Social services districts which received a portion of the reallocated funds should note that this increase will not be sustained in their allocation for year two of CCDBG. CCDBG subsidy funds for the period beginning October 1, 1991 must be liquidated by September 30, 1993.


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Lack of participation in year one of the CCDBG subsidy program does not render social services districts ineligible to receive year two program funds. Instructions concerning application for year two funding will be issued when the grant to New York State becomes available.
