New York's Jobs FIRST initiative represents the key to a major restructuring of the current welfare system to emphasize the values of work and family responsibility. Soon, several districts will be involved in piloting new approaches to delivering services to the public assistance population. These new approaches will help us move from a system that primarily dispenses benefits to one that tries to prevent dependence in the first place. For those that do need cash assistance, our efforts will be geared to helping them achieve self-sufficiency.

In order to succeed in this effort, we will all need to view our jobs differently and think about public assistance in different ways. We have planned a series of teleconferences and other events to reach as many people as possible, to acquaint them with the key elements of Jobs FIRST. The first Satellite Teleconference is scheduled for Thursday, March 31 from 1:00 to 3:00 PM and will feature Commissioner Michael Dowling and Allegany County Commissioner Joan Sinclair. They will discuss the Jobs FIRST program and the vision of welfare reform as well as take questions from participants across the state.
