Your district's check, which represents the distribution of funds for the Mentally Disabled for the period January 1, to March 31, 1996, as provided by the Long Term Care Legislation, has been either deposited into your local district's MMIS Escrow Account utilized to satisfy the requirements of the Inter-Governmental Transfer, or has been sent to your district for deposit into Revenue Account A-3602.

Please take special note that the issuance of the LCM, accompanying the Mentally Disabled (MD) Overburden payment will be discontinued. Since this is a continuing process, fiscal instructions will be incorporated into the Fiscal Reference Manual. The MD Worksheet will be attached to settlement documents. MARS reports (MR-0-64, MR-0-65) are, and have been, available at the local level. This change will not affect the timing of the payment or the process in general.
