Section 2

I. Purpose:

The purpose of this INF is to provide local district staff with a corrected and updated version of the SSI Benefit Levels Chart. The chart is a resource tool, which assists local workers who perform necessary case processing and maintenance related to SSI clients. This chart replaces a previously issued chart, which was an attachment to GIS 00TA/DC021.

II. **Background:**

> The Social Security Administration (SSA) made an error in calculating the cost of living adjustment (COLA) for January 1999. This revised chart takes into account the corrected COLA increases, which

> are being implemented in August by SSA. Effective August 1, 2001, SSI recipients will be receiving

SSI benefits based on the new amounts in the revised SSI Benefits Level Chart.

Previous versions of the SSI Benefits Level chart were only available in DSSP/InfoOffice software,

which often made sharing the chart electronically difficult. This revised chart was developed in

Microsoft Word to alleviate the sharing and distribution problem.

III. **Program Implications**

No specific action is warranted by the issuance of the revised Benefits Level Chart. It is simply a tool to

assist local district staff.
