III. Program Implications

Medicaid policy may differ from Temporary Assistance (TA) policy. Sanctions or requirements applying to cash programs may not apply to Medicaid. Any questions about Medicaid policy, for the above questions or any others, should be referred to the county's local district Medicaid liaison.
