#### I. Purpose

The purpose of this release is to notify local districts that the following form is now **obsolete**:

DSS-2215-Report of Claim/Benefit Restoration Determination Food Stamp Program (Rev.10/83).

# **II. Background**

In 2001, New York State OTDA staff provided statewide training on USDA's changes to the Food Stamp claims regulations. One of the federal changes was to mandate that local districts provide a monthly breakdown of the client's overpayment, as well as the previous and post-overpayment benefit. At the training, local districts were provided a format by which they could collect this information and were told to discontinue using the DSS-2215: "Report of Claim/Benefit Restoration Determination Food Stamp Program" (Rev.10/83). Local districts were informed that NYS OTDA was in the process of developing and printing a form that could be used by local districts to meet this mandate.

In 2002, the LDSS-4778: "Calculation of Total Overpayment Amount" was printed, delivered and made available for use statewide. The DSS-2215: "Report of Claim/Benefit Restoration Determination Food Stamp Program" (Rev.10/83) is now officially obsolete.

### **III. Program Implications**

Any remaining supplies of the DSS-2215: "Report of Claim/Benefit Restoration Determination Food Stamp Program" (Rev.10/83) must be destroyed.

Local districts are reminded that, in the rare instances when a CNS notice is unable to be used to establish a claim, the LDSS-4778: "Calculation of Total Overpayment Amount" or a local district's local equivalent that captures the same information, **must** also be sent.
