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TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE

<u>Chapter 109 - Standard of Monthly Need, Personal Needs Allowance</u> [Senate 7388 by Senator Meier, et al.]

Increases the standards of monthly need for determining eligibility and payment of federal Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and additional State payments to the aged, blind and disabled to reflect SSI benefit increases that may result from any cost-of-living adjustment occurring between January 1, 2002 and June 30, 2002 and makes corresponding changes to personal allowances provided to residents of congregate care facilities.

<u>Chapter 246 – Protection of Earnings</u> [Senate 7515 by Senator Saland, et al.]

Exempts the full-time employment income of a student who is a dependent child from consideration in determining eligibility for and the amount of public assistance benefits and excludes student income of a dependent child from consideration when applying the requirement that the gross earned and unearned income of a household not exceed the poverty level.

<u>Chapter 333 – Food Stamp Application Form</u> [Assembly 10216-A by Assemblyman Ortiz, et al.]

Requires the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance to develop a simplified application form for the food stamp only program. The form is to be developed in consultation with food stamp outreach organizations and consideration given as to how the form may be used to reach as many potential applicants as possible, especially those over 60 years of age and those who are employed.

<u>Chapter 686 – Utility Services</u> [Senate 6778-B by Senator Wright, et al.]

Addresses situations in which the utility providing energy distribution services and the utility providing energy as a commodity are not the same entity by establishing procedures for termination of utility service for non-payment, allocating costs and payments in the event of termination and extending the protections of the Home Energy Fair Practices Act to energy consumers who use alternative energy suppliers.

Requires that the court in a child support proceeding consider the availability of health insurance benefits and insure that health insurance benefits are provided for the benefit of the child.
