Section 2

I. Purpose

- □ To inform local districts that the January 1, 2008, cost of living adjustment (COLA) for RSDI (Title II regular and disability Social Security benefits) and SSI (Title XVI Supplemental Security Income) has been set at 2.3%; and
- □ To provide local districts with the SSI Benefit Levels Chart effective January 1, 2008.

II. Background

Every year, the Social Security Administration (SSA) adjusts RSDI and federal SSI benefits to reflect the increase in the cost of living. This increase is based on the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) between the third quarter of the current year and the third quarter of the previous year.

The January 1, 2008, COLA for RSDI and federal SSI benefits has been set at 2.3%. As authorized by Chapter 132 of the Laws of 2007, the full amount of the 2008 federal COLA will be passed along to all recipients of an optional or mandatory SSI State supplementation.

In addition to receiving a pass-through of the federal COLA provided by Chapter 132, Part C of Chapter 57 of the Laws of 2006 established a COLA on the State share of the SSI benefit for recipients in Enhanced Residential Care – Congregate Care Level 3 facilities. Therefore, Level 3 residents will also receive an increase in the State supplement component of their monthly SSI grant.

Residents of Congregate Care facilities will also see an increase in their Personal Needs Allowances (PNAs).

The attached *SSI Benefit Levels for 2008* chart reflects the 2.3% federal COLA increase and the statutory changes noted above. It is provided as a resource for informational purposes. The chart can also be viewed on CentraPort under Desk Guides and on the OTDA Intranet site within the Center for Employment and Economic Supports under Desk Guides/Aids.

The increases in client income of Temporary Assistance and Food Stamp recipients will be addressed by the annual Mass Rebudgeting. See ABEL Transmittal 07-3 for more information about the annual Mass Rebudgeting.
