I. Purpose

OTDA's Center for Employment and Economic Supports (CEES) is charged with responding to inquiries from Local Departments of Social Services on a variety of Temporary Assistance (TA) issues. This Informational Letter (INF) contains the most recent set of questions and answers on TA issues.

II. Background

The Questions and Answers attached to this document relate only to TA and do not include questions and answers from Food Stamps (FS) or the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP), although the Center for Employment and Economic Supports (CEES) continues to be responsible for all issues and questions relating to TA, FS, and HEAP.

If you have questions regarding this release, please contact the Temporary Assistance or Employment and Advancement Services Bureau directly at the above-referenced number. Policy issues relating to FS and HEAP should continue to be directed to the appropriate policy bureau.

III. Program Implications

Medicaid policy may differ from TA policy. Sanctions or requirements applying to cash programs may not apply to Medicaid. Any questions about Medicaid policy should be referred to the appropriate NYS Department of Health (DOH) local liaison.
