Section 2

I. Purpose

The purpose of this Informational Letter is to inform local social services districts (SSDs) that there is no cost of living adjustment (COLA) for Title II Retirement, Survivors and Disability (RSDI) Social Security benefits and Title XVI Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits for January 1, 2016. The updated SSI/SSP Benefit Levels Chart with an effective date of January 1, 2016 is attached.

II. Background

The Social Security Administration (SSA) adjusts RSDI and federal SSI benefits to reflect the increase in the cost of living. Any COLA increase is based on the change in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) from the third quarter of the last year a COLA was determined to the third quarter of the current year.

III. Program Implications

There was no increase in the CPI-W from the third quarter of 2014 (the last year a COLA was determined) to the third quarter of 2015, therefore, under existing law, there can be no COLA in 2016.

The attached SSI and SSP Benefit Levels Chart for 2016 reflects the 0% federal COLA. The chart is provided as a resource for informational purposes. The chart can also be viewed on Centraport under Desk Guides and on the OTDA Intranet site within the Center for Employment and Economic Supports under Desk Guides/Aids.

Due to the 0% COLA for Social Security and SSI income, there will NOT be a mass rebudgeting of federal benefit income of Temporary Assistance and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients.

The 2016 Medicare Part B Premium amount for 2016 will be \$104.90, the same as it was in 2015. Those individuals currently receiving Medicare who filed an individual tax return in 2014 with a yearly income of \$85,000 or less and couples who filed a joint tax return with a yearly income of \$170,000 or less will pay \$104.90 in 2016 for a Part B Premium. Those individuals who filed an individual tax return in 2014 with a yearly income above \$85,000 and up to \$107,000 or couples who filed a joint tax return with a yearly income above \$170,000 and up to \$214,000 will pay \$146.90 in 2016.

The following individuals will see the increase in their Medicare Part B Premiums in 2016:

- Those new to Part B in 2016;
- Those who don't get Social Security benefits;
- Those who get Medicare and Medicaid and Medicaid pays the premium; and
- Those individual whose income is above a certain amount.

Please note, the corresponding Personal Needs Allowance (PNA) for persons in Congregate Care Levels 1, 2 and 3 remains unchanged from the 2015 levels.
