SUBJECT: Electronic Disqualified Recipient System (eDRS)

The purpose of this GIS message is to advise social services districts (SSD) that connectivity to the Federal SNAP IPV (eDRS) database has been restored. Users of the Welfare Management System (WMS) and myWorkspace Clearance Report will receive a valid code (Y or N) for the recipient SNAP IPV indicator.

Any recipients that received an “*” during the out of service period will be processed through a nightly batch process. The WINR9510 report for these recipients will begin production again this evening. As a result of the service blackout, district staff should expect a larger than normal WINR9510 report.
