

Affidavit of Support Sponsor Information



Purpose

Use this Tip Sheet to learn how to get Form I-864/I-864EZ, Affidavit of Support Under Section 213A of the INA, and Form I-864A, Contract Between Sponsor and Household Member, information from SAVE. This Tip Sheet uses the terms “sponsor” and “sponsors” to refer to sponsors who execute a Form I-864 or Form I-864EZ, as well as household members who sign and submit Form I-864A, because sponsor deeming and agency reimbursements processes may apply to both.

This Tip Sheet also clarifies that you should not submit an additional verification request for sponsor information if sponsor deeming and agency reimbursement exceptions apply. Additional guidance regarding this scenario is provided in the Step 2 guidance below.

Background

If a benefit applicant is requesting one or more federal means-tested public benefits (Medicaid, CHIP, TANF, SNAP/Food Stamps, or Supplemental Security Income), your agency may need sponsor information to count (“deem”) sponsor income and assets as part of determining benefit eligibility.¹ If your agency has provided a federal means-tested public benefit to a sponsored immigrant, then your agency may also need sponsor information to seek reimbursement from the sponsor for the unreimbursed costs of the benefit. You will also need to know the date that the sponsored immigrant was granted their immigrant status (known as the Grant Date).

Step 1: Create a Case

After you enter the benefit applicant’s name, date of birth, and at least one unique immigration identifier (such as their A-Number or Form I-94 number), SAVE will display a list of public benefits for which your agency may use SAVE, and will prompt you to indicate for which benefits your agency is requesting immigration status information.

If you select one or more federal means-tested public benefits, SAVE will automatically return any Grant Date and sponsor information because that information is required when your agency determines eligibility for a federal means-tested public benefit. The lock icon indicates that SAVE will automatically return this information to your agency.

Step 2: Review Response

If you selected one or more federal means-tested public benefits and the benefit applicant is a Lawful Permanent Resident (LPR) (including a Conditional LPR, also known as a Conditional Permanent Resident) who may be sponsored, then SAVE will provide the name, address, and Social Security Number of each sponsor and household member for the agency to use in performing sponsor deeming and agency reimbursement actions.

If there is no sponsor or household member, SAVE will provide a message saying "Not Applicable" in the Sponsors/Household Members field.

In some situations, the initial SAVE response may instruct you to institute additional verification if you need sponsor information.

Please Institute Additional Verification if you need sponsor information

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Please note that you do not need sponsor information if sponsor deeming and agency reimbursement are not applicable. Reasons sponsor deeming may not apply include, but are not limited to, the following situations:

- Benefit applicant earned (or can be credited with) 40 qualifying quarters of coverage under Title II of the Social Security Act at the time of the means-tested public benefit application;
- Benefit applicant has not received any amount from a sponsor or household member and would be unable to obtain food and shelter without the public benefit (indigent as detailed in 8 U.S.C. § 1631(e));
- Benefit applicant is a child or pregnant woman who is lawfully residing in the United States and receiving medical assistance from a State under the Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP) or Medicaid, if the state has elected the option in accordance with sections 1903(v)(4)(A) and 2107(e)(1)(N) of the Act (often referred to as the “CHIPRA 214 option,” after the section of the CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2009, which added this option to titles XIX and XXI of the Act);
- Benefit applicant is applying for SNAP benefits and is a member of the sponsor’s household or is under 18 years old per Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002, P.L. 107-171; and
- Benefit applicant or their child meets the requirements of a battered spouse or child per 8 U.S.C. 1631(f).

If you determine that sponsor deeming and/or agency reimbursement applies and you still need sponsor information, institute additional verification by selecting “Still not sure? Institute Additional Verification,” and then requesting sponsor information in the Special Comments field.

Guidance for Web Services Users

Your agency may use SAVE through a Web Services (system-to-system) connection rather than the Internet browser access method reflected in the sample screens in this Tip Sheet. To implement the change described in this updated Tip Sheet, Web Services users should request sponsor information through additional verification only when the initial SAVE response states that the benefit applicant is an LPR with a Class of Admission (COA) listed in the chart below, does not include any sponsor information, and you need sponsor information for sponsor deeming or agency reimbursement purposes. Please note that your agency does not need sponsor information if sponsor deeming and agency reimbursement exceptions apply (please see Step 2 above for additional information about these exceptions).
