### Section 2

The purpose of this GIS is to notify Social Services Districts (districts) that there will be no Public Assistance Reporting Information System (PARIS) match disseminated to districts for this quarter (June 2024).

---

### Section 3

Each quarter, through the PARIS computer matching agreement, the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) submits a file of active TA, SNAP, and MA recipients to the Department of Defense's (DOD) Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC). This file is matched against other State's data and once those matches are completed and returned to OTDA, they are disseminated to the districts to be investigated.

OTDA was advised that the PARIS computer matching renewal agreement between the DMDC, State Public Assistance Agencies (SPAA), and the Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Children and Families (ACF) has not been signed by DMDC yet.

As such, all states were advised not to submit their files for the second quarter (June 2024 match) because DMDC will not process the PARIS match until the renewal agreement is signed.
