The purpose of this GIS is to inform social services districts (districts) that additional program funds for the 2024-2025 regular benefit component have been made available to support the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP). Therefore, the Regular benefit component will reopen effective January 25, 2025.

Applications for 2024-2025 Regular heater and heat-included benefits must be accepted beginning Saturday, January 25, 2025. Districts will be informed of a revised closing date by GIS. All HEAP applications must be processed in accordance with instructions found in the New York State HEAP Manual and 24-LCM-15.

The online HEAP application for the regular benefit component will be available on MyBenefits and on ACESSHRA effective January 25.

Temporary Assistance (TA) Implications:

Districts must continue to explore the availability of, and eligibility for, Regular, and/or any available Emergency HEAP benefits before issuing a Family Assistance (FA), Safety Net Assistance (SNA), Emergency Assistance to Needy Families with Children (EAF), Emergency Safety Net Assistance (ESNA) or Emergency Assistance for Adults (EAA) payment to meet a utility or non-utility energy emergency.

Additional Guidance to Districts:

Districts must continue to submit their HEAP Pending Case Report in eReports on a weekly basis, as outlined in 24-LCM-15.
