Section 2

The purpose of this GIS is to provide social services districts (districts) with additional guidance regarding the 2024-2025 Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) Regular benefit component.

All HEAP applications must be processed in accordance with instructions found in the New York State <u>HEAP Manual</u> and <u>24-LCM-15</u>. There are no changes to payment line coding or the voucher review process.

Applications received between January 21, 2025 and the 2024-2025 Regular HEAP reopening date of January 25, 2025 that did not receive a 2024-2025 program year Regular HEAP benefit must be re-evaluated and issued a Regular benefit if eligible.

This includes:

- Households that applied for Regular HEAP and were denied using denial code F08 HEAP Application Received After HEAP Program Year Closing Date.
- Households that were approved for an Emergency benefit but did not receive a current year Regular benefit because the Regular benefit was not available.

• Households that did not receive a current year Regular benefit, applied for Emergency HEAP and met all basic eligibility requirements, but were denied due to Emergency benefit-specific eligibility criteria including, but not limited to, the household was not in an emergency situation, had excess resources, or the applicant was not the customer of record.
