

Homeless Housing and Assistance Corporation Executive Management Team

In 1990, the Legislature established the Homeless Housing and Assistance Corporation (“HHAC”) as a public benefit corporation to issue the necessary bonds to finance the costs of developing projects under the Homeless Housing and Assistance Program (“HHAP”) (see, Private Housing Finance §45-c). As a public benefit corporation, HHAC falls within the definition of a “State Agency” for purposes of the Public Officers Law. HHAC is a subsidiary of the New York State Housing Finance Agency (“HFA”). HHAC has no employees of its own and it is staffed by the NYS Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (“OTDA”). The Commissioner of OTDA serves ex officio as its chairperson, and the President of the Housing Finance Agency (“HFA”) and a third member named by the Commissioner of OTDA also serve ex officio as members of the HHAC Board of Directors.
