
## ELIGIBILITY FLOW FOR Summer EBT Benefits for Children

 $\underline{\text{FDPIR}}\text{-} \ \text{Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations}$ 

FRPL- Free and Reduced-Price Lunch- a child's FRPL eligibility is established based on their participation in SNAP, TANF, FDPIR, or Medicaid\*, or if they are homeless, migrant, runaway, foster, enrolled in Head Start or an eligible pre-kindergarten program, or through an income application. The New York State Education Department collects this student level data through the Student Information Repository System (SIRS) or the Information and Reporting Services Data Exchange (IDEx), which is then transferred to the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance.

NSLP- National School Lunch Program

**SNAP**- Supplemental Nutrition Program

**TANF-** Temporary Assistance for Needy Families

\*Medicaid-Limited to certain Medicaid eligible children that have income that is at or below 133% of poverty before the application of blocks, disregards or exceptions.
