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# Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

## September 2006

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### Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 557,886 in September 2006, decreasing by 10,097 (-1.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$150,412,564 in September 2006, decreasing by approximately \$7.6 million (- 4.8%) over August 2006.

### Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,781,387 in September 2006, increasing by 3,317 (+0.2%) over August 2006. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$188,610,610 in September 2006, decreasing by \$372,152 (-0.2%) over the previous month.

### Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For September 2006, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 648,803 increasing 1,372 (+0.2%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in September 2006 totaled \$324,352,663, decreasing by approximately \$2.5 million (-0.8%) from August 2006.

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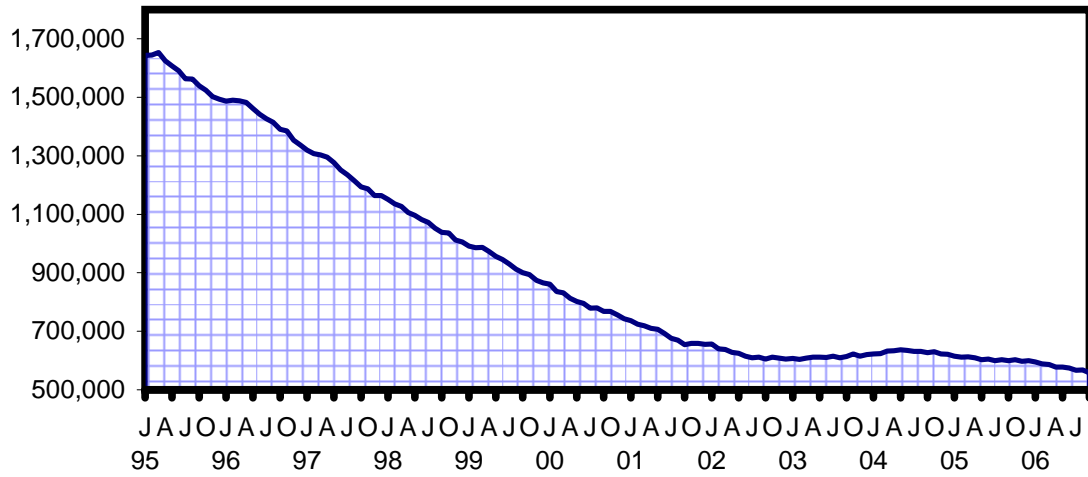
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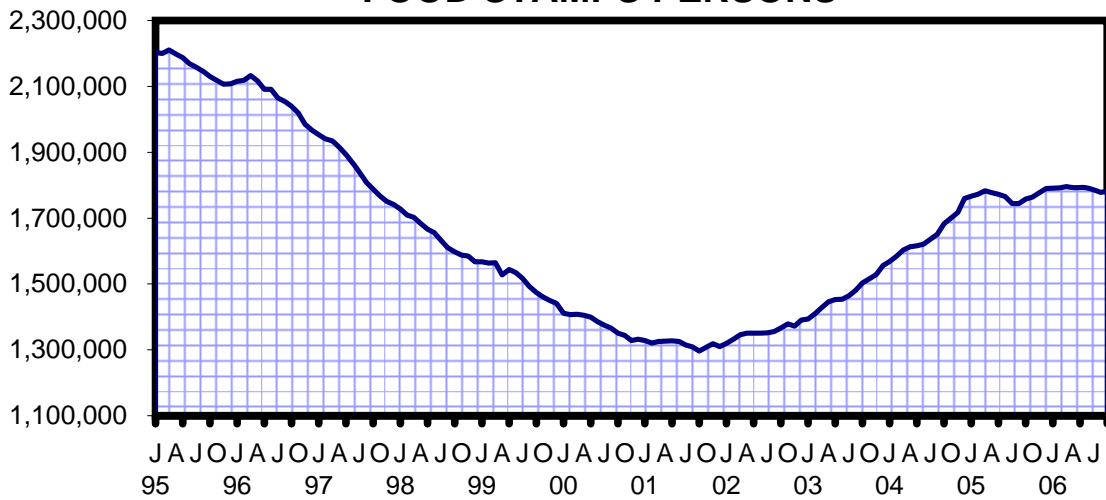
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# NEW YORK STATE JANUARY 1995 - SEPTEMBER 2006

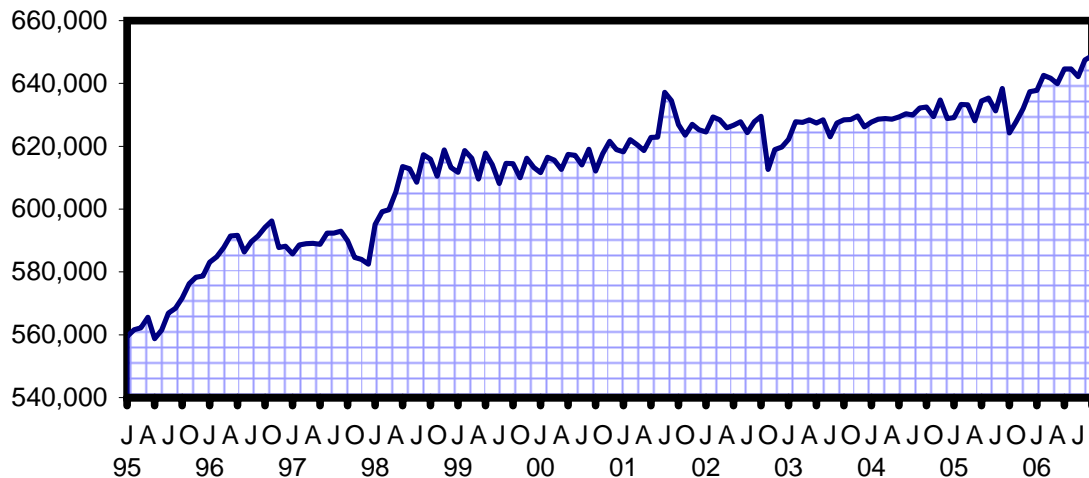
## TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS
