AUGUST 2007

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 529,521 in August 2007, increasing by 2,278 (+0.4%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$152,634,652 in August 2007 increasing by approximately \$7.6 million (+5.2%) over July 2007.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,816,805 in August 2007, increasing by 23,889 (+1.3%) over July 2007. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$196,488,593 in August 2007, increasing by approximately \$2.7 million (+1.4%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For August 2007, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 650,702 increasing 3,829 (+0.6%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in August totaled \$339,475,258 increasing by approximately \$2.8 million (+0.8%) from July 2007.

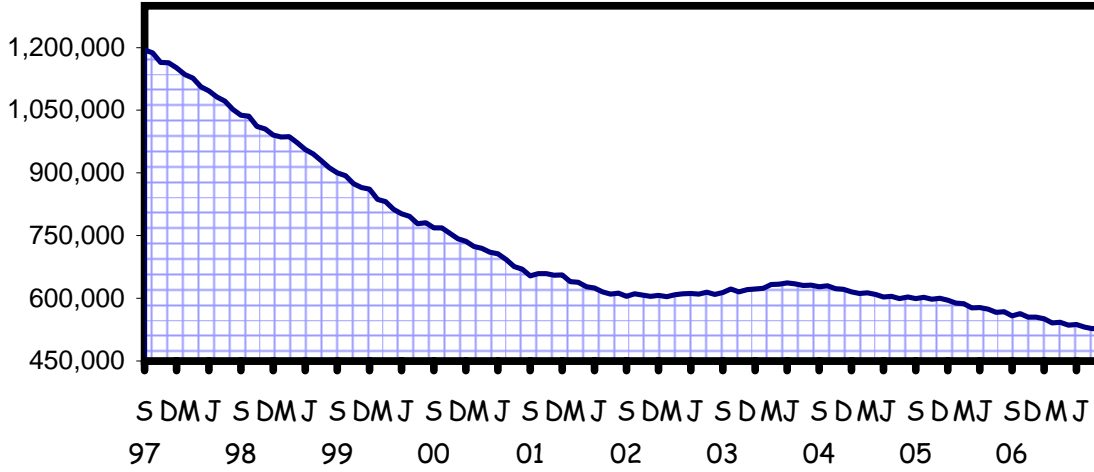

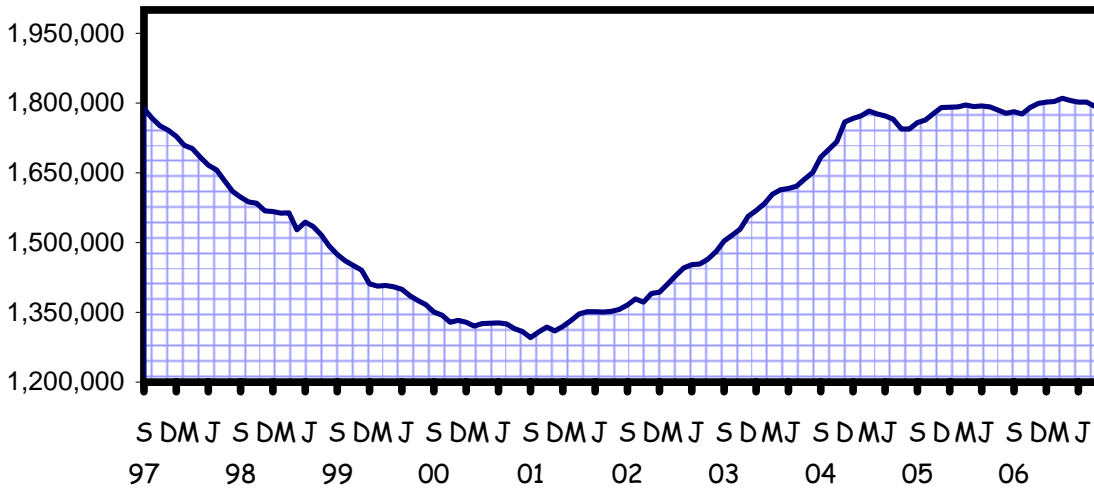

 TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS**

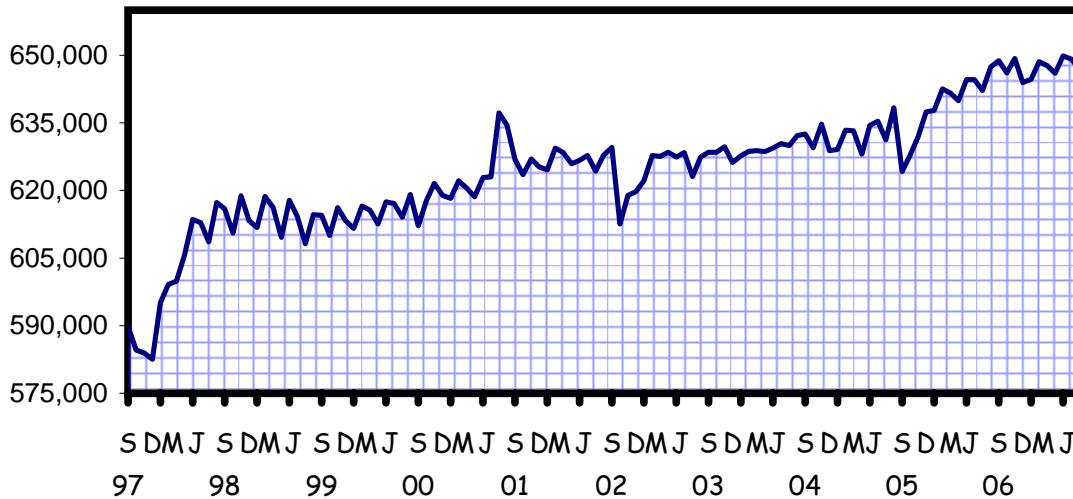


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
